The Sedgemoor (Parishes) (Amendment) Order 1981

Made - - - - 25th March 1981

Coming into Operation 31st March 1981

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Sedgemoor (Parishes) (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1981.

2. In the Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1981(b), in article 5(1) (which defines the new parish of Burtle by reference to a continuous red line on boundary maps 10 and 11), there shall be added "other than any part of the Parish of Chilton Polden south of the line for the time being of the centre of the South Drain".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Article 5(1) of the Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1981 constituted a new parish from parts of certain parishes, including the Parish of Chilton Polden, by reference to a red line on maps referred to. The red line includes an area of the parish which had been cut out on an adjustment of the district council's draft recommendations. This order excludes the area from the new parish.

SEDGEMOOR DISTRICT: PARISH REVIEW

As pointed out in your letter of 17 March, Map 10 attached to the Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1981 did not take into account the amendment to the boundary between Chilten Polden Parish and the new parish of Burtle, which was agreed following your letter of 10 July 1979 to the Secretary of the Local Government Boundary Commission. You know from Mr Slesoritis' reply of 20 March that we are correcting matters by an amending order: this was made on 25 March, and I enclose a copy for your records.
