Comment text:

The Parish of Bramshott and Liphook is currently not warded. I am one of the three East Hampshire District Councillors who represent the Parish at the District Council. I have been a District Councillor for more than 6 years, and in that time, together with my fellow District Councillors, have been able to represent the concerns of the residents from across the whole of the Parish, including the settlements of Passfield and Conford. There has never been any conflict of deciding which district Councillor should represent which area. We cover the whole of the area and are well known to the residents. The benefit of having three DC's representing the whole area is that we are able to be approached by any of the residents, and can pick up if another District Councillor is not available. Our predecessors also represented the whole parish and we continue their dedication to Bramshott and Liphook. I cannot see any merit in dividing the Parish into three separate Wards, and think that it would in fact be detrimental to the response which we, collectively, are able to give to our residents.
