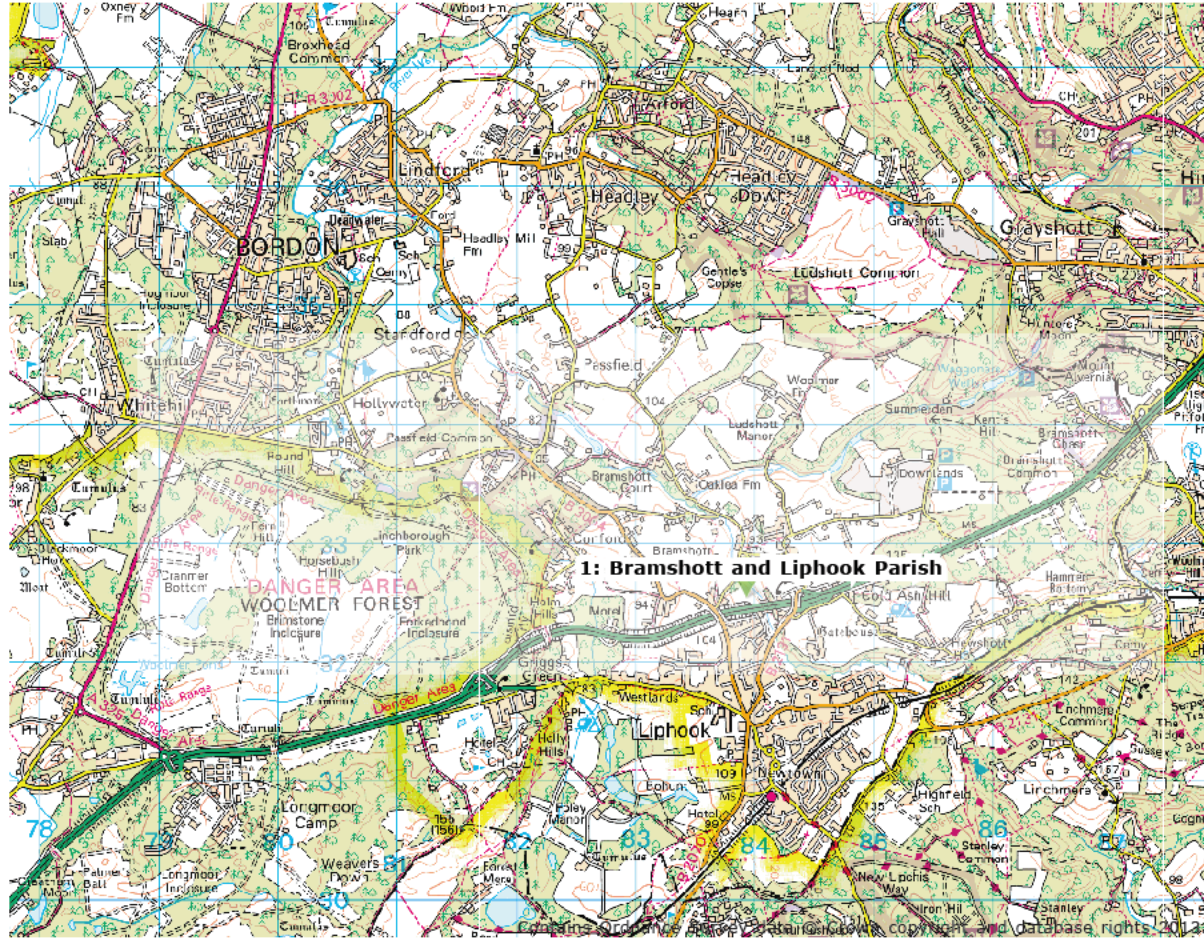

Annotation 1: Bramshott and Liphook Parish

### Comment text:

I consider that Bramshott and Liphook Parish should be arranged into Single Member Wards. Currently the three district councillors all cover the same geography: there is no overt or known individual geographic responsibility. At local meetings/events the councillors (who are incidentally of the same party) tend to sit together and talk amongst themselves; there is no apparent sense of purpose or wish to consult parishioners or adequate leadership. The ward is too big to make it reasonably feasible for a fresh candidate to canvas the entire parish of Bramshott & Liphook - that is unfair - voting then tends to be overly dominated by party affiliation and to a degree that is inappropriate and unnecessary at this level. In my view a single member warding will better focus responsibility and be likely to improve the calibre of candidate.
