Radford and Park ward seems to have three very different communities. The Park Estate is very different to Radford in terms of need and community. The ward also contains the roads that run in the triangle between Ilkeston Road and Derby Road which has a very high student occupancy. This section of roads would most likely be better off in Dunkirk and Lenton which already has a high student population. Equally, The Park Estate likely has more in common with sections of Bridge (Lace Market for example) than it does with Radford. I suspect a two-member ward consisting of The Park Estate and Bridge (or even some of Arboretum) would make much more sense. Radford and Park is already a large ward with Park making up around 20% of the population. Radford could survive as a ward on its own with very little extra being needed to be added if Park was removed. This would hopefully lead to communities being better grouped together.
