CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1988

Made	5th September 1988
Coming into force-	
for the purpose of	
article 1(2)	1st October 1988
for all other purposes	1st April 1989

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Sedgemoor District Council for proposals about parishes in the district:

Citation and commencement

1.-(1) This Order may be cited as the Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1988.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 1st October 1988 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).

(3) For all other purposes this Order shall come into force on 1st April 1989.

Interpretation

2. In this Order "boundary map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Map of the Sedgemoor (Parishes) Order 1988", and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976.

Transfers between parishes

3.-(1) The part of the parish of Fiddington which is marked A2 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Nether Stowey.

(2) The part of the parish of Nether Stowey which is marked A1 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Fiddington.

(3) The parts of the parish of Spaxton and of the Eastern Quantocks ward of the district of Sedgemoor which are marked A3 and A4 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Fiddington and to the Dowsborough ward of that district.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

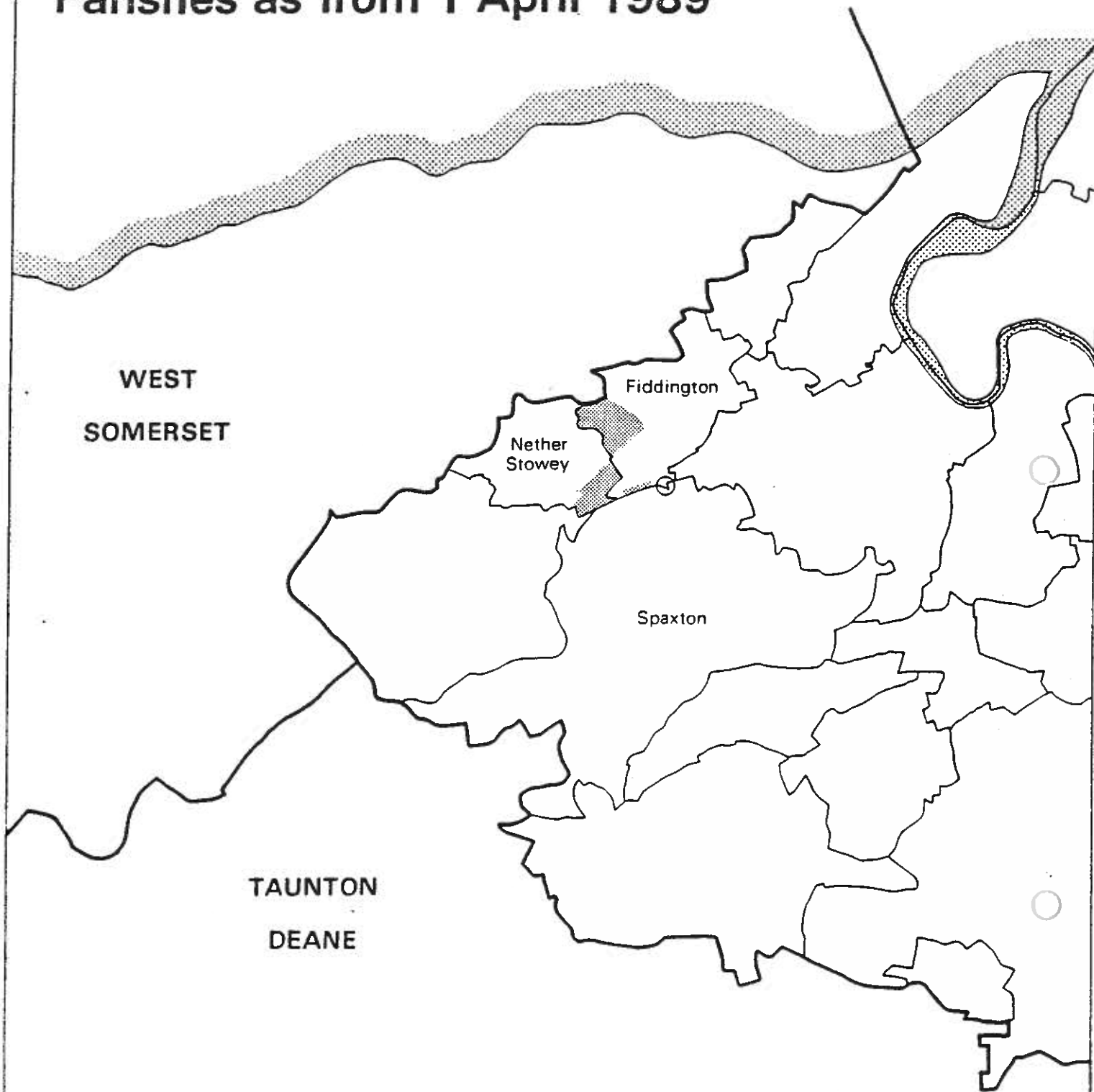
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order transfers areas between the parishes of Fiddington, Nether Stowey, and Spaxton in the district of Sedgemoor. A consequential change to local government electoral areas is made.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) gives a general guide to the areas affected. Prints of the detailed boundary map (described in article 2) may be inspected at all reasonable times at the office of the Sedgemoor District Council and at the office of the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.
