May I register my dissatisfaction with your proposals when you created the Wyre Forest Rural Ward. The proposed ward is geographically excessively large and would not be easy to manage. The inclusion of Shatterford and Upper Arley, goes against the criteria you set out of maintaining natural boundaries and should be included in one of the Bewdley wards. The geographical size of this ward will fail to reflect the identities and interest of local communities. Each of the Parishes in the proposed ward, will I feel, lose their local identity and may end up being represented by councillors who may not have the local knowledge that I feel is invaluable for district councillors to best serve their electorate.
