### ELECTORAL BOUNDARY REVIEW OF THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF KNOWSLEY

#### RESPONSE TO THE BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR ENGLAND

At a meeting of the Local Government Governance Committee of Knowsley Town Council held on Thursday 9 October 2014, it was **UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** that Knowsley Town Council's response to the Electoral Boundary Review of Knowsley Metropolitan Borough, be as follows:

*"Knowsley Town Council fully supports the proposal as submitted to the Boundary Commission for England by Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council for the following reasons:*

- *the proposal compliments and enhances the integrity and continuity of the council electoral warding arrangement,*
- *Knowsley Town Council understands the principal and necessity of the reduction in the warding arrangements as proposed by Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council,*
- *Knowsley Town Council is in agreement with the ward naming as proposed by Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council,*
- *Knowsley Town Council is satisfied with the existing Parish Council warding arrangements and would not anticipate any future changes".*
