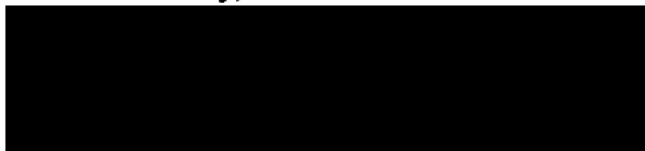

**CLAYGATE PARISH COUNCIL'S COMMENTS ON THE
LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION'S DRAFT PROPOSALS
FOR NEW WARD BOUNDARIES IN ELMBRIDGE.**

Our original submission made, we believe, a strong case for leaving the current Borough Ward boundary of Claygate undisturbed. Additionally all borough-wide schemes proposed that Claygate should be retained in its own separate three-member ward.

Claygate Parish Council welcomes and supports the draft recommendation of the LGBCE which states "We consider the evidence received for Claygate is compelling and justifies a three-member ward wholly containing Claygate parish, notwithstanding the relatively high electoral variance. We adopt this ward as part of our draft recommendations".
