The South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1998

Made - - - 21st December 1998

Coming into force 1st April 1999

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect (without modification) to a recommendation made to him by South Cambridgeshire District Council, following a review conducted by them in accordance with Part II of that Act, for the alteration of the area of parishes within the district of South Cambridgeshire:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1998 and shall come into force on 1st April 1999.

Alteration of parish areas

2. - (1) The area marked "A" on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Orwell and shall become part of the parish of Wimpole.

(2) In paragraph (1) "the map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions, marked "Map of the South Cambridgeshire (Parishes) Order 1998" and deposited at the offices of the Secretary of State of the Environment, Transport and the Regions and at the offices of the South Cambridgeshire District Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
