Thank you for consulting the Parish Council on the Electoral Review of Eastleigh Borough Council. Members of Fair Oak and Horton Heath Parish Council considered their response to the consultation at the Full Council meeting held last night.

The Parish Council were in support of reducing the number of Councillors to 39. We felt it was important that the Parish is divided into wards within our own Parish boundary. The Parish Council is expecting a further 1500 homes (approved planning) to be built up to the period of 2021. This includes the 950 homes proposed for an area west of Horton Heath which currently straddles the West End parish.

The new community will be linked with the existing habitat of Horton Heath sharing new village facilities and schools. Splitting the community into two different boundaries will cause confusion and lack cohesion when dealing with local matters.
