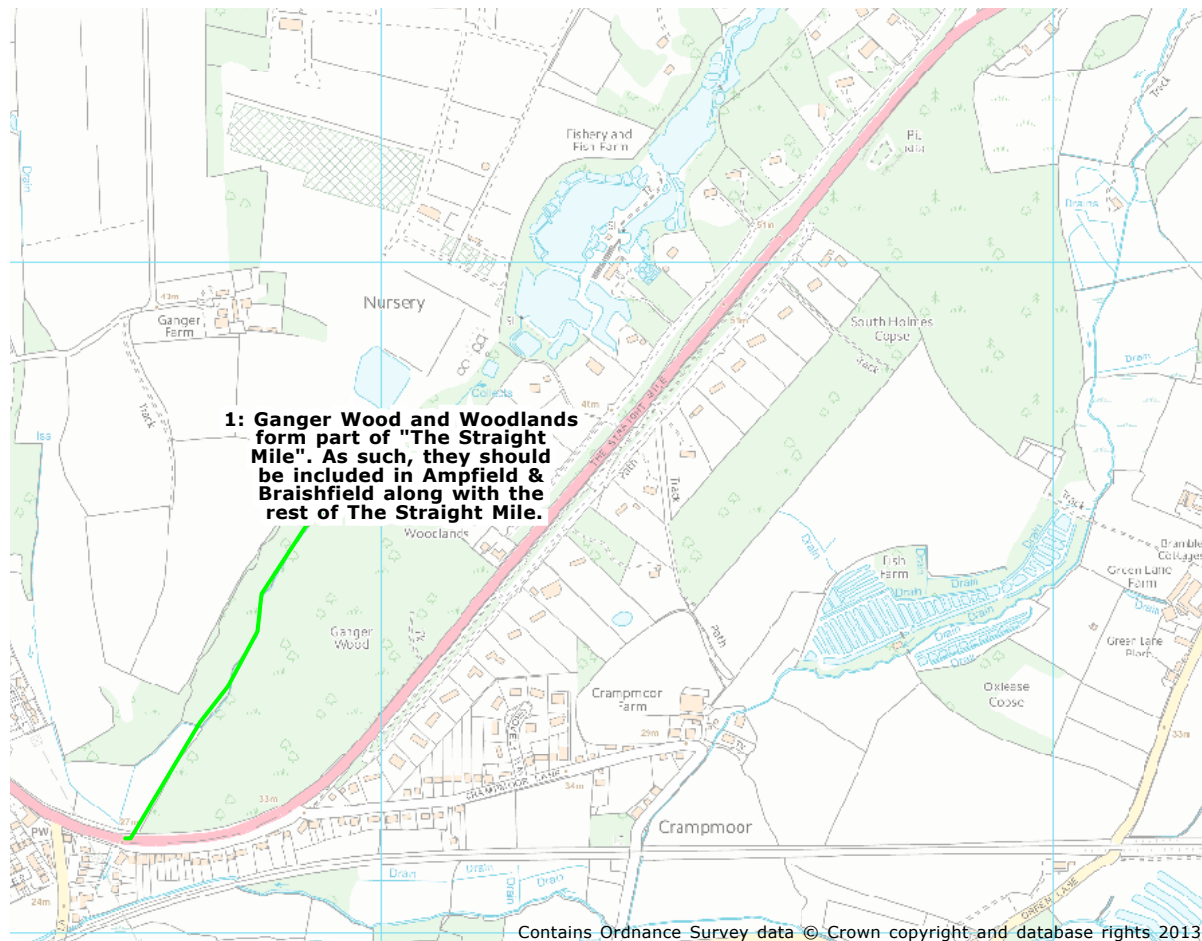

Annotation 1: Ganger Wood and Woodlands form part of "The Straight Mile". As such, they should be included in Ampfield & Braishfield along with the rest of The Straight Mile.

**Comment text:**

The current boundaries have The Straight Mile split between Ampfield and Romsey Extra, with roughly half of the properties being in each of the wards. The boundary changes result in ALMOST all of The Straight Mile being in Ampfield & Braishfield. This is a huge improvement as the issues that affect The Straight Mile and those that affect Ampfield & Braishfield are both rural in nature and very similar, but entirely different from those that affect Romsey Cupernham, which is suburban in nature. However, Woodlands and Ganger Wood are also located on The Straight Mile and have much more in common with the rest of The Straight Mile, rather than the suburban Romsey Cupernham ward. The boundary of Ampfield and Braishfield should be straightened out to follow the line of Ganger Wood and meet the A3090 on the north side at the same point as where the boundary meets the south side, thus including Ganger Wood and Woodlands within Ampfield & Braishfield instead of within Romsey Cupernham.
