Comment text:

I write to comment about the proposals submitted by the Conservative Group on Council by the ward of Selsdon and Ballards. Ballards was joined to the ward in the 1998 submission and has never fitted. It is geographically separate and rises 200 feet above Selsdon and sits in the north east corner of the ward. It would easily be married to the Monks Hill estate as they are adjacent to each other and linked by woods and foot paths. South of Monks Hill is Selsdon Park Road which is difficult to cross and forms a physical barrier between Monks Hill and Forestdale. In my view Forestdale should be with Selsdon Vale in the Selsdon ward as the dividing line is a row of slightly raised stones in the road. These two areas are very much one community. Forestdale has its own residents association which has been in existence for about 50 years and its own community centre. The existing Selsdon ward also has a residents association which celebrated its 90th birthday last year. Selsdon is often referred to as a village, it still has a village club, and is a very very strong community which I have the privilege of representating on Croydon Council for over 36 years.
