LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES  
CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Harborough (Parishes) Order 1993  
 Made - - - - 10th November 1993  
 Coming into force-  
 for the purposes referred to  
 in article 1(2) 1st December 1993  
 for all other purposes - 1st. April 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) by the Harborough District Council for proposals about parishes in the district:

## Citation and commencement

1. -(1) This Order may be cited as the Harborough (Parishes) Order 1993.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on 1 December 1993 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (b).
- (3) For all other purposes, this Order shall come into force on 1st. April 1994.

## Interpretation

### 2. In this Order-

"the district" means the district of Harborough, and  
"district council" means the Harborough District  
Council;

"electoral division" means an electoral division of the  
county of Leicestershire;

"map" means one of the 13 maps prepared by the  
Department of the Environment, marked "Maps of the  
Harborough (Parishes) Order 1993", and deposited  
in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government  
Area Changes Regulations 1976; and

"ward" means a ward of the district;

## Abolition of parishes

3. -(1) The parish of Stretton Magna shall cease to exist and the areas of it which are marked as shown in column 1 of the following Table on the map indicated in column 2 shall be transferred from that parish to the parish named in column 3.

(2) The parish of Whatborough shall cease to exist and its area, shall be transferred to the parish of Tilton-on-the-Hill.

## Consequential changes to district wards and electoral divisions

4. The area marked A on maps 11 and 12, which formed part of the parish of Stretton Magna, shall be transferred to the Thurnby ward and to the Billesdon electoral division.


Other transfers between parishes

5. Each area which is marked as shown in column 1 of the following Table on the map indicated in column 2 shall be transferred from the parish named in column 3 to the parish, and to the ward, and electoral division (if any) named in column 4.

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order affects parishes in the district of  
Harborough by-

- (a) abolishing the parishes of Stretton Magna and  
Whatborough and transferring their areas to other  
parishes;
- (b) making changes to the boundaries of  
seventeen other parishes.

The map forming part of this note (page 5)

gives a general guide to the changes  
effected. Prints of the detailed maps described in  
article 2 may be inspected at all reasonable times at  
the offices of the Harborough District Council and at  
the offices of the Secretary of State for the  
Environment located in 2, Marsham Street, London SW1P  
3EB.

Consequential changes are made to the  
boundaries of district ward and county electoral  
divisions.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations  
1976 (S.I.1976/246, amended by S.I.1978/247) contain  
general provisions regarding the effect of orders such  
as the present one.
