The South Somerset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015 No 1

Made 16th January 2015

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

South Somerset District Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 84 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 15th January 2015

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement(a)

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the South Somerset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015 No 1.

(2) Article 5 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

(3) For the purposes of:

proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of Lopen, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015, this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"district" means the district of South Somerset;

"ordinary day of election of councillors" has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Elections for the parish of Lopen

4. The election of all parish councillors for the parish of Lopen shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Lopen

5. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Lopen shall be seven (7).

Electoral register

6. The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary (if any) for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Order date

7. 1st April 2015 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
