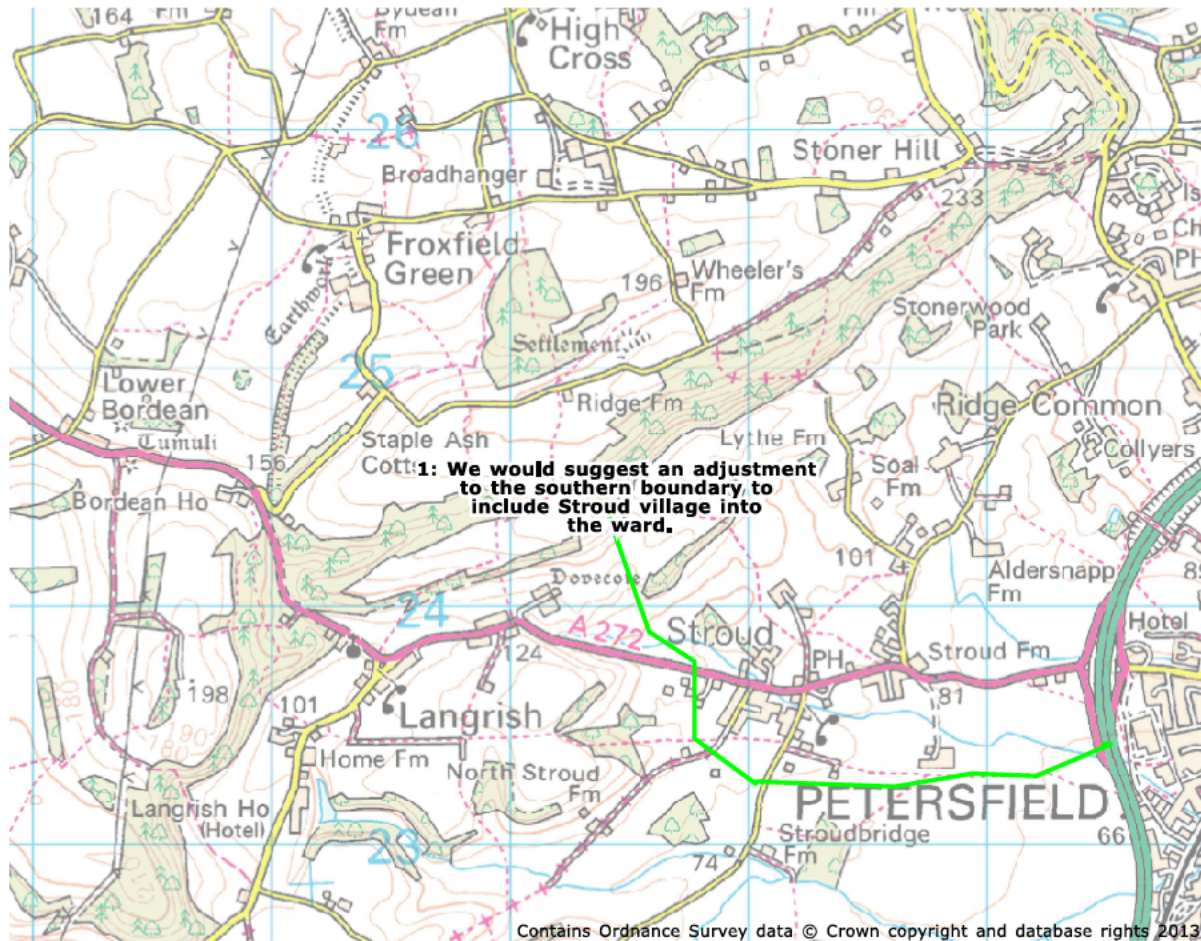

Annotation 1: We would suggest an adjustment to the southern boundary to include Stroud village into the ward.

**Comment text:**

The chief concern for Steep Parish Council is the exclusion of Stroud Parish from our ward. We work closely with Stroud Parish, to the extent that we even share a newsletter. We also work closely in many other aspects: we share a lengthsman with them, we are working together with them to introduce a joint Community Speedwatch scheme, we share church services with the Stroud Chapel actually lying in Steep and Ridge Common Lane links the two villages seamlessly. We appreciate that this would distort the numbers slightly but this would appear to us to be less important than separating the two villages into separate wards with separate District Councillors. We welcome the inclusion of Sheet with whom we also work closely, particularly our Steep Marsh hamlet to the Northeast of our parish who travel through Sheet on a daily basis. We understand the adjustment of the northwestern boundary to move Colemore and Priors Dean to Ropley and Tisted with whom they have a closer affinity.
