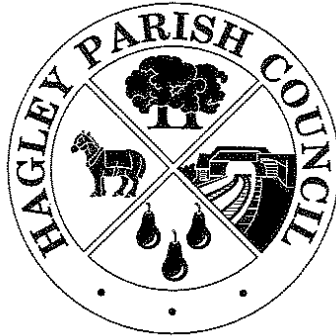

Hagley Parish Council supports the commission's boundary proposal for Hagley i.e. that the whole of the village of Hagley is within two district wards. Although the map was difficult to dissect the inclusion of a small number of properties previously identified as being included in Clent has correctly now being included in Hagley ward. There remains (we believe) a very few properties in Thicknall Lane that remain in Belbroughton and Clent, as proposed by Bromsgrove District Council. Hagley Parish Council believes that these too should be included in the Hagley ward to complete the Hagley village in total. Hagley Parish Council fails to understand the need or purpose of a Hagley South parish ward. A single Hagley Parish Ward should cover the two District Wards as one only. This will stop any split in the parish council should there be a different political representation in the district ward. Hagley Parish council usually operates by consensus as one voice covering the whole of a ward that has very similar characteristics and needs. To reconfirm Hagley Parish Council supports the present proposal presented by the commission than its predecessor presented by Bromsgrove District Council.
