

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The South Somerset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order No 1 2012

Made 16th March 2012

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

South Somerset District Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 83 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(a) ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 15th March 2012:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section(b):

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 98(4) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement(c)

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the South Somerset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order No1 2012.

(2) It shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"district" means the district of South Somerset;

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the South Somerset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order No1 2012" and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Stoke Trister with Bayford

4. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Stoke Trister with Bayford shall remain at 7.

Numbers of parish councillors for the parish of Pen Selwood

5. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Pen Selwood shall remain at 7.

Alteration of parish areas

6. The area coloured red on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Pen Selwood and shall become part of the parish of Stoke Trister with Bayford

Electoral register

7. The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Transfer of property, rights and liabilities

8. The land, property, rights and liabilities described in Schedule 1 shall transfer from the Pen Selwood Parish Council to the Stoke Trister with Bayford Parish Council on the date specified in column (2) of that Schedule.

Order date

9. 1st April 2012 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008(a).

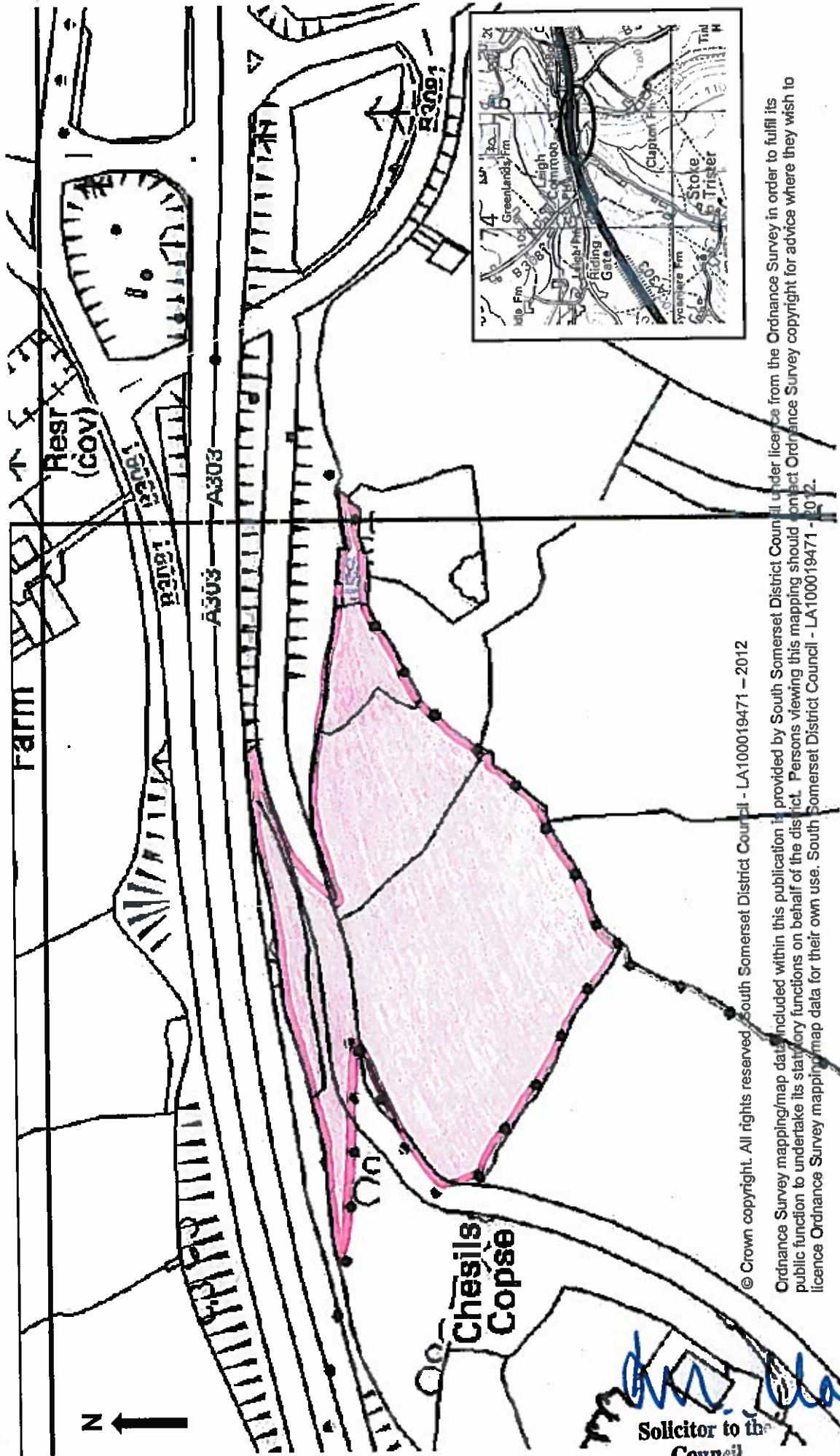
