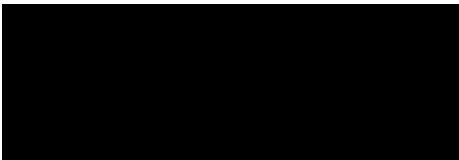
LGBCE Electoral Review of Teignbridge District Council

Consultation on the draft warding arrangements concludes on Monday 31 October.

Teignbridge Council members considered the draft recommendations on the proposed warding patterns at its Full Council meeting on 26 September 2016. After some discussion members resolved the following:

- (a) To acknowledge the draft warding patterns as proposed by the LGBCE, including an increase from 46 councillors to 47;
- (b) That Council accepts these proposals are broadly in line with Councils' unanimous recommendation to retain 46 councillors and to adopt a similar warding pattern to the pattern currently in place, with necessary adjustment to ensure electoral equality across the district.
- (c) That the political groups on the Council submit their own recommendations to the LGBCE independent of Council if they wish to see any changes to the LGBCE's recommendations.
