

# LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

## The Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Sutton) Order 2012

*Made 14th February 2012*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

Suffolk Coastal District Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 83 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 26th January 2012:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3), 98(4), 98(6) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

### **Citation and commencement**

- 1.— (1) This Order may be cited as the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Sutton) Order 2012
- (2) Subject to paragraph (3) and (4) below, this Order comes into force on 1st April 2012
- (3) Article 7 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2012
- (4) For the purposes of:
  - (a) this article, and
  - (b) article 5
  - (c) proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish Councillors for the parish of Sutton Heath to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2012 this Order shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

## **Interpretation**

### **2. In this Order—**

“district” means the district of Suffolk Coastal District Council

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Sutton) Order 2012” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

“new parish” means the parish constituted by article 4

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

## **Effect of Order**

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

## **Constitution of a new parish**

4.— A new parish, comprising the area outlined with a red line on the map, shall be constituted within the district of Suffolk Coastal.

(1) The name of the new parish shall be Sutton Heath

(2) In consequence of paragraph (1) of this article, the area of the new parish shall cease to be part of the existing parish of Sutton.

## **Calculation of budget requirement**

5. For the purposes of regulation 3 of the Local Government Finance (New Parishes) (England) Regulations 2008 there is specified in relation to the parish of Sutton Heath the sum of £2672

## **Parish council for the parish of Sutton Heath**

6.— There shall be a parish council for the parish of Sutton Heath.

(1) The name of that council shall be “Parish Council of Sutton Heath”

## **Election for the parish of Sutton Heath Parish elections**

7. — (1) Elections of all parish councillors for the parish of Sutton Heath shall be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2012.

(2) The first term of office for every parish councillor elected on the ordinary day of elections in 2012 shall be reduced to three (3) years. The next election being 2015 and every four (4) years thereafter.

**Number of parish councillors for the parish of Sutton Heath**

8. The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Sutton Heath shall be nine (9).

**Annual meeting of parish council**

9. The annual meeting of the new parish council in 2012 shall be convened by the Head of Legal and Democratic Services of Suffolk Coastal District Council. The meeting shall take place no later than 14 days after the day on which the councillors elected to the new parish council take office.

**Alteration of Sutton Parish**

10.— (1) In consequence of Article 4 the area outlined with a red line on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Sutton and shall become the new parish of Sutton Heath

(2) For the "altered" existing parish of Sutton regulation 10 of the Local Government, England and Wales Council) (England) Regulations 2008 shall apply

**Electoral register**

11. The registration officer for Suffolk Coastal District Council shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

**Transitional provision**

12. Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish of Sutton Heath at the elections to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2012 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by those persons who immediately before 1st April 2012 are the elected councillors for the parish of Sutton.

**Order date**

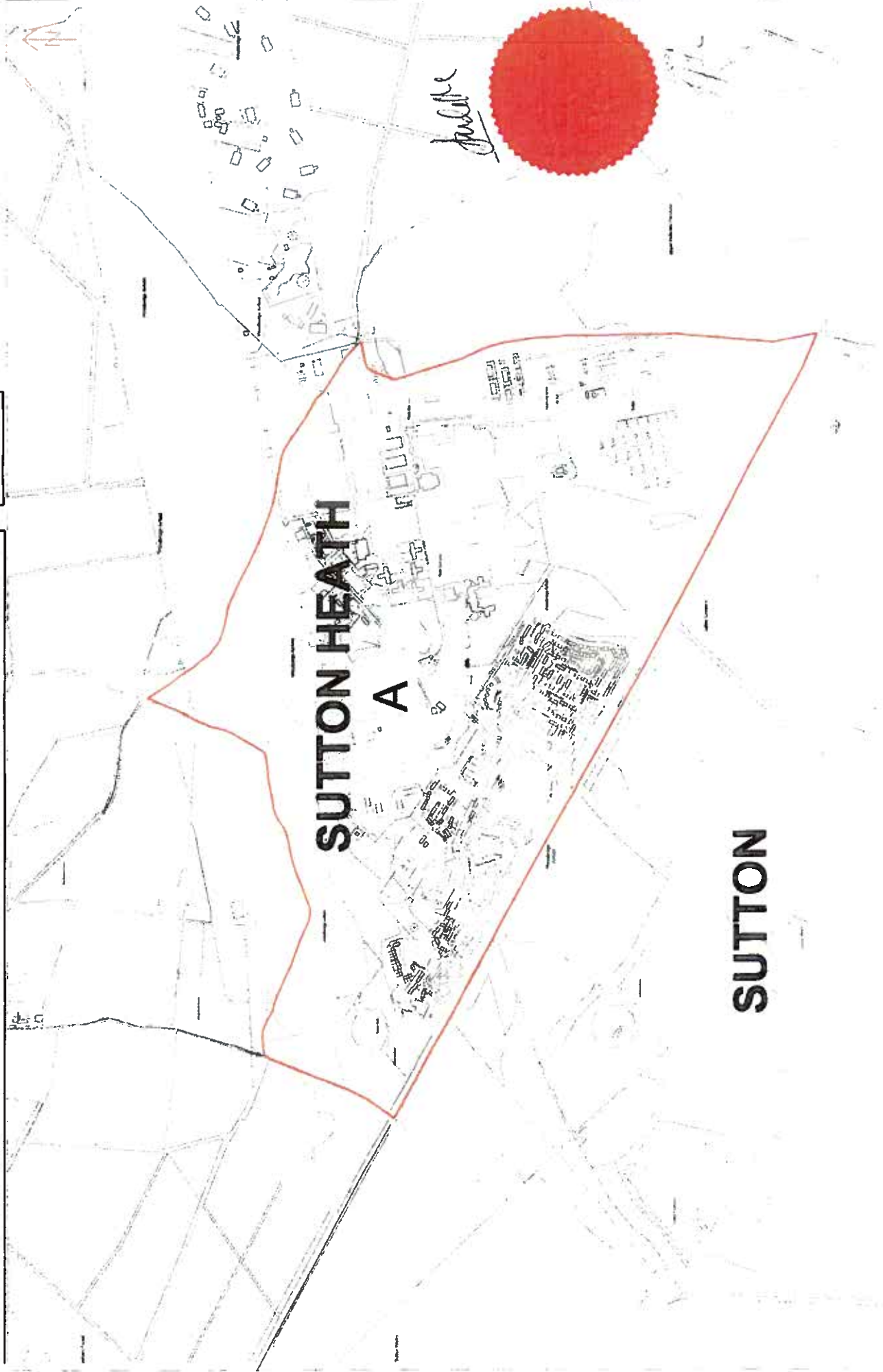
12. 1st April 2012 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008
