The Oldham (Parish of Crompton) Order 1986

Made 5th December 1986

Coming into Operation -

for the purposes described

in article 2(1) 1st January 1987

for all other purposes 1st April 1987

Whereas the Oldham Borough Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), conducted a review as respects parishes in the borough, and made a report to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England which did not include recommendations for change:

And whereas the Commission, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, itself conducted such a review, and decided to make proposals for change to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) and 67(5) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Oldham (Parish of Crompton) Order 1986.

2. - (1) 1st January 1987 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

Creation of new parish of Crompton

3. - (1) In the borough of Oldham, there shall be created, without change to the boundary of any ward of the borough of Oldham, a new parish of Crompton.

(2) The new parish shall consist of the area shown outlined in red on map number 1 of the maps issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Maps of the Oldham (Parish of Crompton) Order 1986".

Parish council for the new parish

4. - (1) There shall be a parish council for the new parish created by article 3.

(2) The new parish shall be divided into four parish wards as shown on the maps numbered 1 and 2 issued as above. The North parish ward shall be represented by 5 parish councillors and the South, East, and West parish wards shall each be represented by 3 parish councillors.

(3) Elections of parish councillors for the new parish shall be held on such day prior to 1st April 1987 as the returning officer shall appoint. The persons elected shall come into office on 1st April 1987, and retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1991.

(4) The proper officer of the Oldham Borough Council shall convene -
the annual meeting of the new parish council; and
the first assembly of the parish meeting for the new parish.

If in the new parish the first assembly of the parish meeting is held before the first annual meeting of the new parish council, the parish meeting may appoint a person to take the chair, who shall have, for the purposes of that occasion only, the powers and authority of a chairman.

(5) In the financial year beginning on 1st April 1987, the Oldham Borough Council shall levy rates in the new parish, and make payments to the new parish council as if the new parish council had issued a precept to that borough council requiring the payment of a sum equal to the product of a rate of 2 pence in the pound, calculated on the total rateable value of the new parish as set out in the valuation list at the beginning of that financial year.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order creates a new parish of Crompton in the borough of Oldham. The map forming part of this note (page 5) gives a general guide to the areas affected as from 1st April 1987.

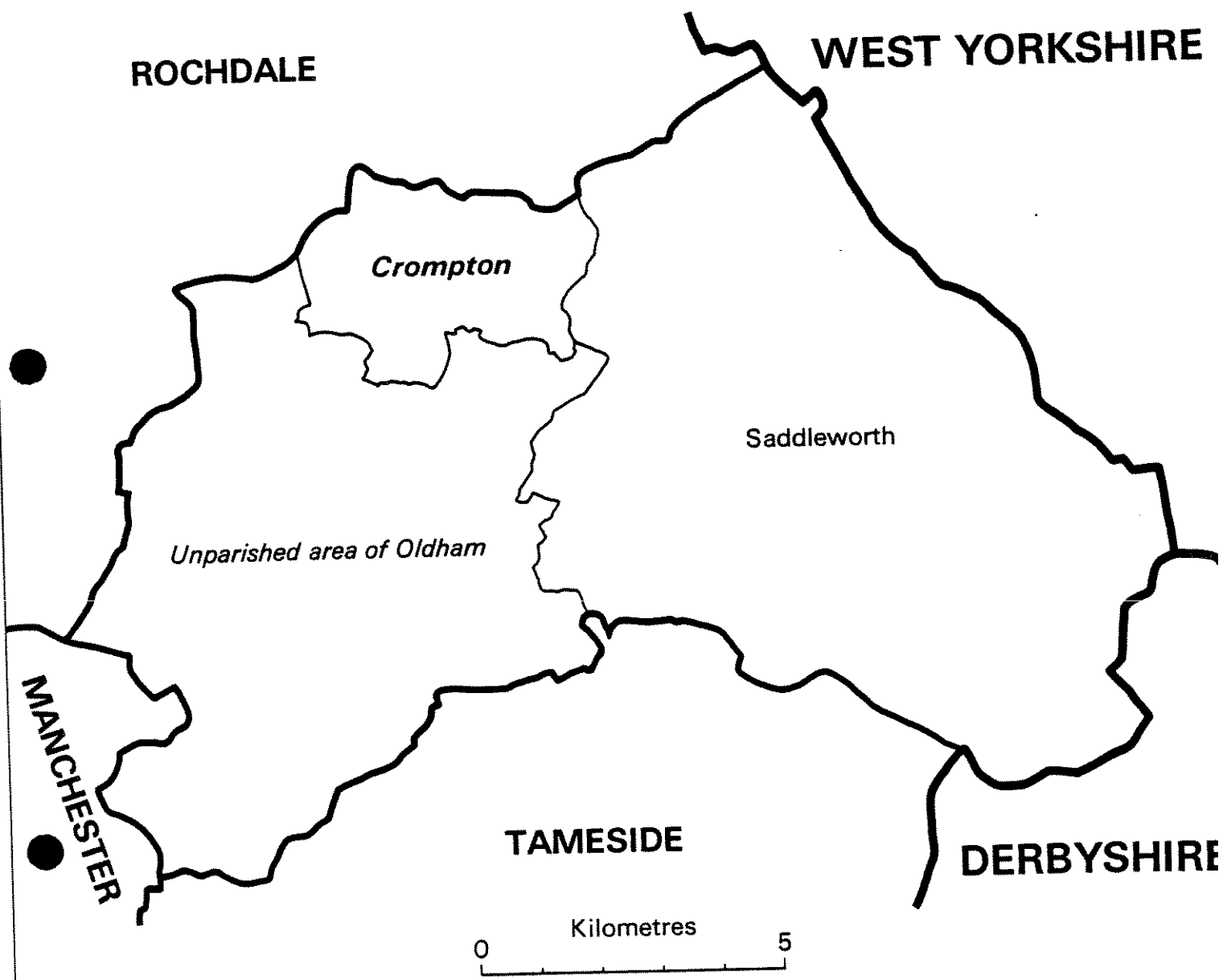
Prints of the detailed boundary maps which are referred to in articles 3 and 4 may be inspected at the offices of the Oldham Borough Council, and may be inspected at or purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

A parish council is established for the new parish. The new parish will have approximately an area of 1202 hectares, a population of 20,431, and a rateable value of £1,852,000.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in article 2(1), contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
