5 LATIMER PARISH COUNCIL - REQUEST TO CHANGE NAME

The Committee considered a request from Latimer Parish Council, made in accordance with Section 75 of the Local Government Act 1972, to change their name to 'Latimer and Ley Hill Parish Council'.

The Parish Council considered that the proposed change was a better reflection of the area that they represented. The Committee noted that the Parish consisted of two wards (Latimer and Ley Hill) with Ley Hill accounting for 65% of the total electors, and also returning five councillors to Latimer's two.
