Comment text:

I am appealing against the proposals of the current Croydon Council. Purley and Coulsdon Town have been closely linked since before the days of the Purley and Coulsdon Urban District Council, then in Surrey and abolished in the mid 1960s. The geography of the area reinforces the links, with major train, bus and road links in the valley joining the two communities. Regarding Anglican parish boundaries, currently St Swithun's is in Coulsdon West ward and St Mark's is in Woodcote. These parishes, already linked, will be joined closer next year via a joint benefice and should be in the the same Borough at least. The residents association, PWRA, covers the whole of the currently defined . Current proposals would split the PWRA area up and could cause its demise. The hills and valleys in this area should be respected in any boundary changes and OS topographical,maps used when making boundary change proposals.
