**ELECTORAL REVIEW OF SEDGEMOOR DISTRICT COUNCIL: DRAFT  
RECOMMENDATIONS**

Having considered the representations received during the initial stages of the review, the Commission today publishes its draft recommendations on the future electoral arrangements for Sedgemoor. A copy of the report can be accessed via our website [www.lgbce.org.uk](http://www.lgbce.org.uk).

We have informed the national headquarters of the main political parties, the MP and MEPs with constituency interests in the area, all parish and town councils, the police authority and all people who responded to our initial consultations.

We are now undertaking a period of consultation on our draft recommendations and are seeking the views of local people. It would be helpful if your Council could further publicise the Commission's draft recommendations by displaying the posters sent to your council and taking such other steps as it considers appropriate to bring the review to the attention of the public and other interested parties. We will send copies of all representations to you at the end of this consultation stage. I would be grateful if you would kindly make them available for public inspection on receipt. Copies of representations will also be posted on the LGBCE's website and made available for inspection at the Commission's offices, by appointment.


Representations must be submitted to the Commission by **19 July 2010**. I should stress that the Commission has not finalised its conclusions and, in light of further evidence, may put forward final recommendations which differ from those set out in the draft recommendations. We therefore encourage all those who have a view to write to us, whether they agree with our draft recommendations or not. It is very important that those who oppose our draft recommendations should suggest alternatives which are supported by evidence. All representations received during the consultation period will be taken into account and the Commission will then consider whether or not to amend its draft recommendations. When the final recommendations are published, copies will again be sent to your Council and the other stakeholders detailed above.
