CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Burnley (Parishes) Order 1982

Made	- - - -	29th September 1982
Coming into Operation - for the purposes described in article 2	- - - -	1st January 1983
for all other purposes	- - - -	1st April 1983

Whereas the Borough Council of Burnley, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the borough;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 13th May 1981, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Burnley (Parishes) Order 1982.
2. 1st January 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

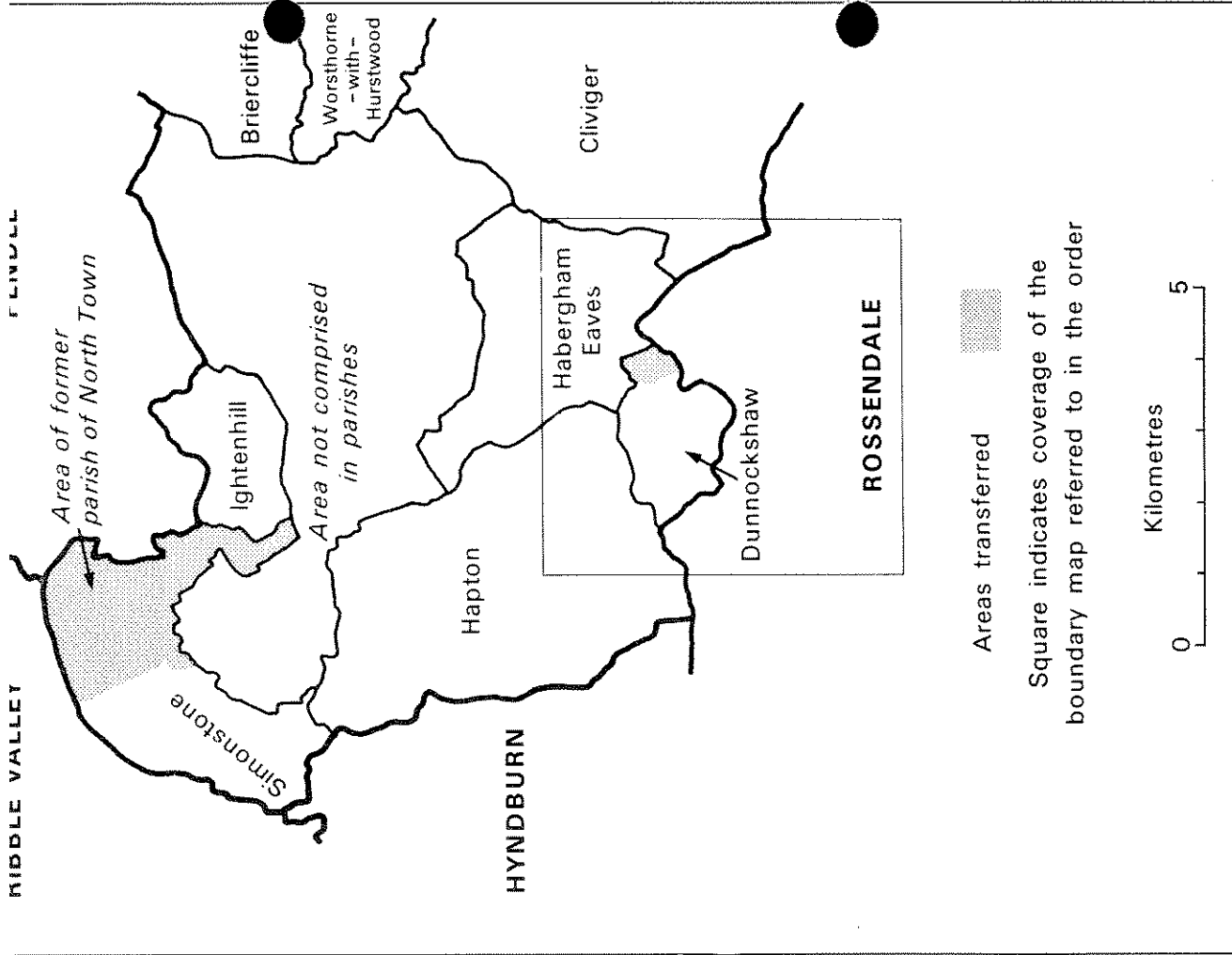
For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

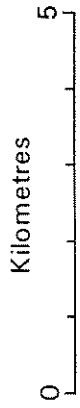
3. In this order—
“the appointed day” means 1st April 1983;
“the boundary map” means the map printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery

"the county" means the County of Lancashire;

"the borough" means the Borough of Burnley; and

"the Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b).

Changes in areas

4.—(1) The Parish of North Town shall be abolished and its area shall be transferred to the Parish of Simonstone.

(2) That part of the Parish of Habergham Eaves which is shown coloured red on the boundary map shall be transferred to the Parish of Dunnockshaw.

Parish councils

5.—(1) The Parish Council of North Town shall be dissolved. For the purposes of any provision of the Regulations which refers to the residuary successor of a dissolved authority, the Parish Council of Simonstone is hereby specified as the residuary successor of such council.

(2) As from the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1983 the number of parish councillors for the Parish of Simonstone shall be increased from 5 to 7.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order—

(a) abolishes the Parish of North Town in the Borough of Burnley, transferring its area to the Parish of Simonstone;

(b) transfers part of the Parish of Habergham Eaves, in the Borough, to the Parish of Dunnockshaw.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) shows the areas.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations defined in article 3 of the order.
