### **ELECTORAL REVIEW OF STRATFORD ON AVON**

On behalf of the Stratford on Avon Conservative Association I confirm that the Association is generally content with the Local Government Boundary Commission for England proposals for that part of Stratford on Avon District that falls into the Stratford on Avon Parliamentary Constituency.

We would however invite you to consider minor amendments to three of the proposed District Wards; namely Brailes and Compton, Ettington and Shipston South.

**Brailes and Compton Ward** – transfer of Burmington from Shipston South to Brailes and Compton.

We acknowledge a slight increase in the variance for Brailes and Compton set at 3% for 2013 but the transfer of Burmington to Brailes and Compton will ease the -1% variance projected for 2019.

Shipston South has a 6% variance set for 2013, the transfer of Burmington from Shipston South will help to ease the variance and in particular the variance of 10% projected for 2019.

Burmington sits well geographically with the proposed ward of Brailes and Compton.

**Ettington** – transfer Barcheston from Ettington to Shipston South.

Barcheston is a hamlet adjacent to and strongly connected to Shipston South. The size of the electorate will make small difference to the variance of Ettington or Shipston South. Barcheston sits geographically well with Shipston South and will help to reduce the elongated nature of the proposed Ettington Ward.
