Your feedback: I appreciate that in an ideal world all Councillors would have the same size electoral base. However, I believe you should allow community cohesion to override this if necessary. With so much electoral apathy already in existence, splitting or artificially combining communities will make this worse.

You will see that Areley and associated villages are currently included in the Bewdley ward. They are on the East side of the river (i.e. detached from Bewdley), and would be better placed with Wribbenhall (given that wards must

become geographically larger).

The possibility of Wolverley & Cookley then joining the enhanced Wribbenhall ward should be considered.

Blakedown and Chaddesley Corbett do not lie naturally with Wolverley and Cookley and I feel the perhaps convenient inclination to add these four rural wards together should be resisted. They do not sit well together culturally. Blakedown and Chaddesley could perhaps be added to Spennells and/or Offmore.

I have not attempted the arithmetic but have tried to emphasise my point about the superiority of community over precise numbers.
