Subject: Objection to Proposal to bring Napier Drive into the Old Dean

Dear sir/madam

I am writing to formally object to the proposal to bring Napier drive into the Old Dean ward.

Napier drive and the surrounding roads are distinctly different to the Old Dean, and very different in the look, pace and value of property.

If our area is brought into the Old Dean, we will be negatively affected by the lack of representation by the council - this is especially important now as there are plans to build developments in our area and the council have been in talks with residents about this, we cannot afford to start these conversations again with representatives that do not understand our area at such a critical time.
