

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order (No.1) 2011

Made - - - - 16 February 2011

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Northumberland County Council (“the council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated September 2010:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act. .

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (No.1) Order 2011.

(2) This order, with the exception of article 5, comes into force on 1st April 2011.

(3) Article 5 comes into force

(a) For the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parish of Hexhamshire, to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013, on 15th October 2012;

(b) For all other purposes on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“county” means the county of Northumberland

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order (No.1) 2011” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act:

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Amalgamation of existing parishes of Hexhamshire and Hexhamshire Low Quarter and constitution of new parish of Hexhamshire

4.—(1) The existing parishes of Hexhamshire and Hexhamshire Low Quarter shall be amalgamated to constitute a new parish comprising the unhatched area outlined in blue on the map.

(2) The new parish shall be known as Hexhamshire.

(3) In consequence of paragraph (1), the existing parishes of Hexhamshire and Hexhamshire Low Quarter shall cease to exist.

Number of parish councillors for the parish of Hexhamshire

5.—The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Hexhamshire shall be 10.

Electoral register

6. The registration officer for the county shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

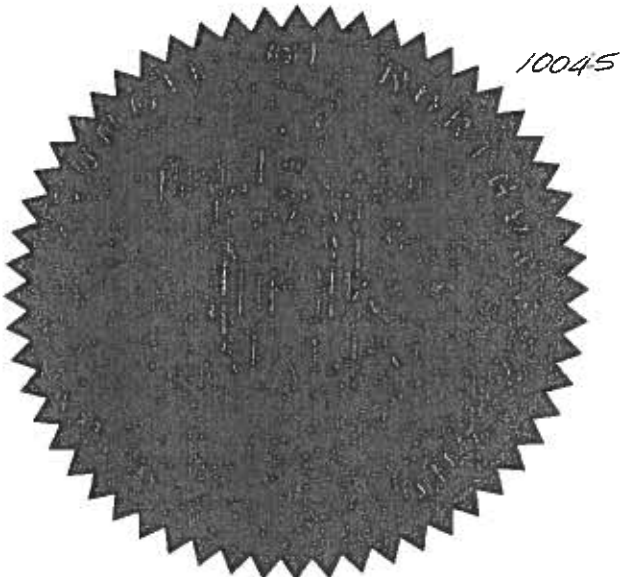
Order date

Revocation

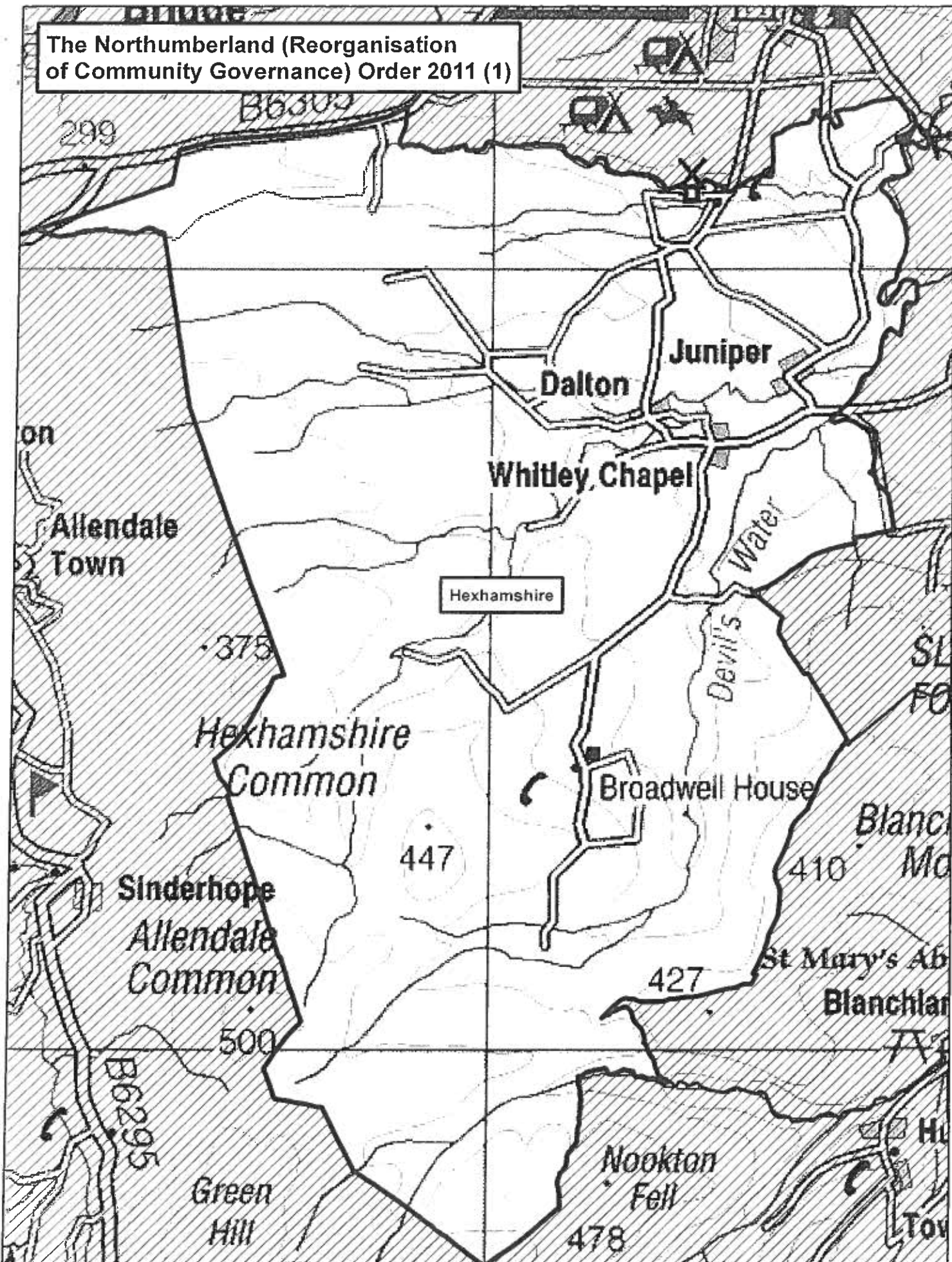
