The Basildon (Parish) Order 2001

Made - - - - 21 September 2001

Coming into force 15 October 2001

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to a petition sent to him under section 11 of that Act, for the constitution as a parish of an area within the district of Basildon of which no part is within a parish and for the establishment of a parish council for that area:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the Basildon (Parish) Order 2001 and it shall come into force on 15 October 2001.

(2) In this Order -

"the new parish" means the parish constituted by article 2;

"the district council" means the district council of Basildon; and

"the map" means the map prepared by the Department for Transport, Local Government and the Regions, marked "Map of the Basildon (Parish) Order 2001" and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999 (b).

Constitution of new parish

2. - (1) A new parish, comprising the area delineated by a blue line on the map, shall be constituted within the district.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Noak Bridge.

Directions to establish parish council

3. - (1) The district council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the new parish.

(2) 1st April 2002 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

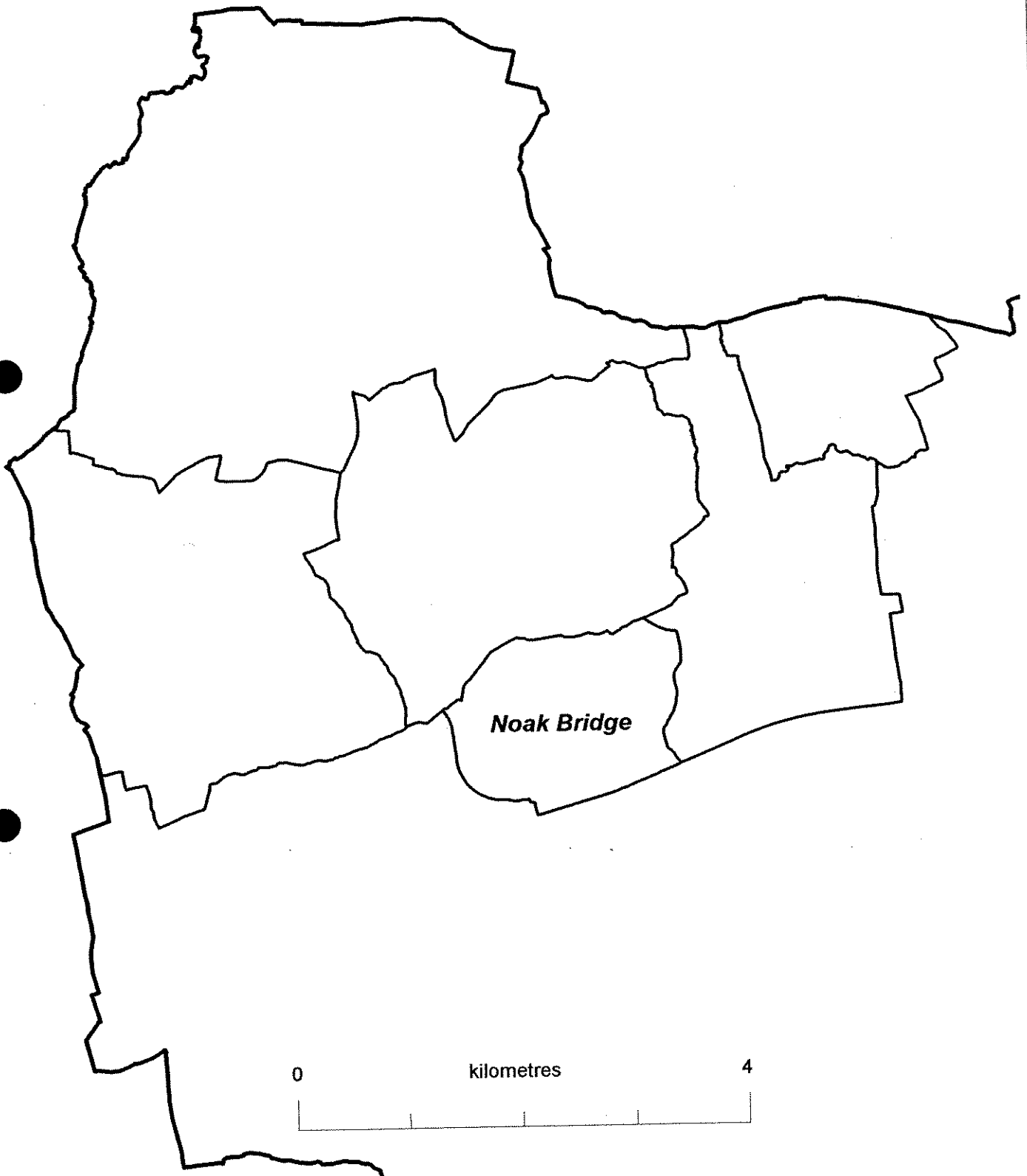
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to a petition sent to the Secretary of State for the creation as a parish of an area within the district of Basildon and for the establishment of a parish council for that area. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the area concerned.

Article 2 creates the new parish, to be called Noak Bridge.

Article 3 directs Basildon District Council to establish a parish council for the new Parish. 1st April 2002 is specified as the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999 which make general provision in relation to orders such as this Order.
