The Colchester (Parishes) Order 1981

Made - - - - 26th February 1981
 Coming into Operation—
 for the purposes described in article 2 - 4th March 1981
 for all other purposes - 1st April 1981

Whereas the Borough Council of Colchester, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the borough;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with a modification:—

Title and commencement

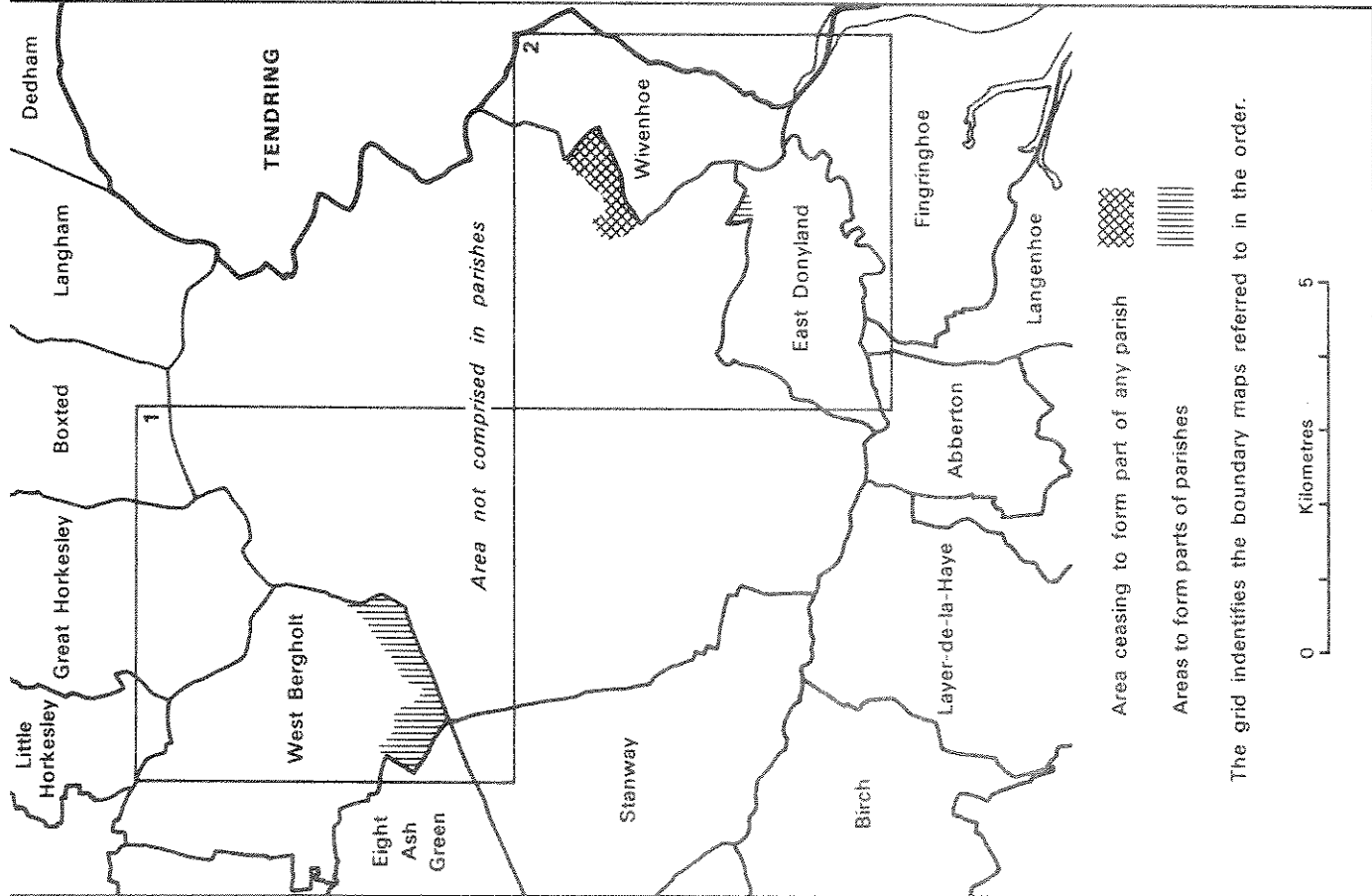
1. This order may be cited as the Colchester (Parishes) Order 1981.
2. 4th March 1981 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.
 For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—
 “the appointed day” means 1st April 1981; and
 “the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(c).

The boundary maps

4. In this order—

“the boundary maps” means the two maps printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey, each such map being marked “Map referred to in the Colchester (Parishes) Order 1981” and with the number of the map; and
any reference to a numbered boundary map is a reference to the map described and numbered as aforesaid.

Changes in areas

5.—(1) The part of the Town of Wivenhoe which is shown cross-hatched red and marked B on boundary map 2 shall cease to form part of any parish.

(2) The part of the area of the former borough of Colchester which is shown hatched red and marked C1 on boundary map 2 shall form part of the Parish of East Donyland.

(3) The part of the area of the former borough of Colchester which is shown hatched red and marked C2 on boundary map 1 shall form part of the Parish of West Bergholt.

(4) The West Bergholt ward of the Borough of Colchester shall comprise the whole of the Parish of West Bergholt as altered. So much of the said ward as will not be comprised in the said parish as altered shall form part of the Lexden ward.

(5) In relation to elections to be held on or after 7th May 1981—

(a) the Constable electoral division of the County of Essex shall include the whole of the Parish of West Bergholt as altered; and

(b) the area which under paragraph (4) is to form part of the Lexden ward shall form part of the Drury electoral division.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

6.—(1) The area of the former borough of Colchester shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and is hereby specified in relation to paragraph (4) of that regulation, and the area comprising—

the first mentioned area other than the parts thereof to which article 5(2) and (3) apply; and

the area to which article 5(1) applies
is hereby specified in relation to the first mentioned area.

(2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) of the Regulations in respect of any parish as altered.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order effects adjustments between parishes in the Borough of Colchester and the part of the borough which is not included in any parish.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) shows the areas. This map also incorporates a grid identifying the maps referred to in article 4 of the order.

Prints of the maps referred to in article 4 of the order may be inspected at the offices of the borough council. Prints may be purchased from the Department of the Environment’s Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations defined in article 3 of the order.
