The Epping Forest (Parishes) Order 1987

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Epping Forest District Council for proposals about parishes in the district:

Citation and commencement

- 1.- (1) This Order may be cited as the Epping Forest (Parishes) Order 1987.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on 1st January 1988 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (b).
- (3) For all other purposes this Order shall come into force on 1st April 1988.

Transfer from the parish of Waltham Abbey to the parish of Nazeing

2. The part of the parish of Waltham Abbey which is marked Area A on the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Map of the Epping Forest (Parishes) Order 1987" and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 shall be transferred to-

- (a) the parish of Nazeing;
- (b) the Bumbles Green ward of that parish;
- (c) the Nazeing ward of the district of Epping Forest;
- (d) the North Weald and Nazeing electoral division of the county of Essex.

Police areas

3. The area transferred by this Order shall cease to be part of the metropolitan police district.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

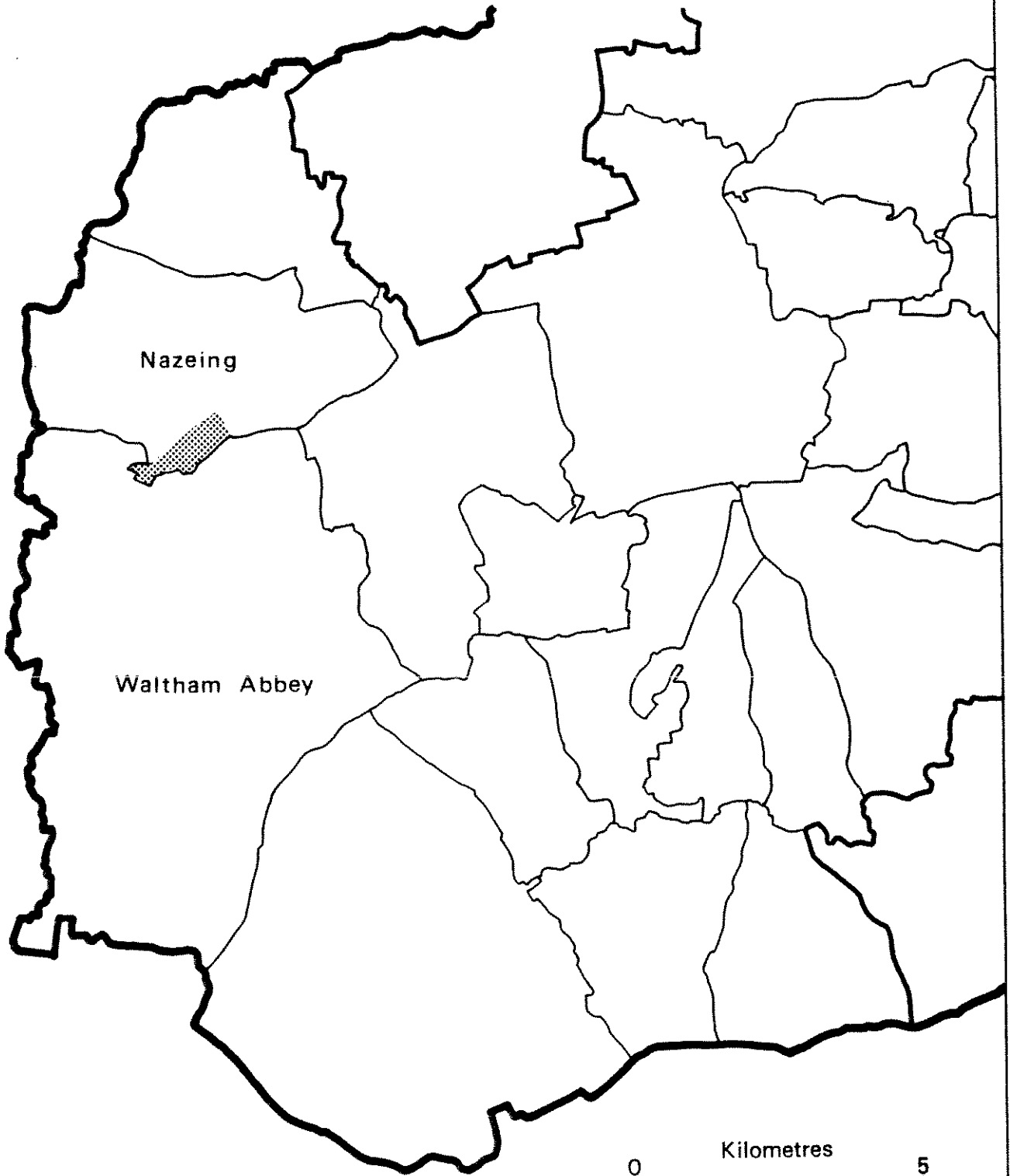
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order transfers an area within the district of Epping Forest from the parish of Waltham Abbey to the parish of Nazeing. Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

Made 25th November 1986
Coming into Operation -
for the purposes described
in article 2(1) 1st January 1987
for all other purposes 1st April 1987

Whereas the Epping Forest District Council, acting pursuant to section 48(3) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the district:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Epping Forest (Parishes) Order 1986.

2. - (1) 1st January 1987 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

Interpretation

3. In this order -

"the boundary maps" means the 6 maps (duly numbered for reference) which are issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Maps of the Epping Forest (Parishes) Order 1986";

"county electoral division" means an electoral division of the county of Essex;
and

"district ward" means a ward of the district of Epping Forest.

Transfers between parishes

4. Each area marked on the boundary maps as shown in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the relevant parish named in column 3 to that named in column 4.

Where in column 5 there is mentioned in relation to any area -

- (a) a parish ward;
- (b) a district ward; or
- (c) a county electoral division;

that area shall additionally be transferred to that ward or division.

Transfers from unparished area to parishes

5. - (1) That part of the unparished area of the former urban district of Chigwell which is marked C1 on boundary map 5 shall become part of the parish

of Lambourne, and shall be transferred to the Lambourne district ward and the Ongar county electoral division.

(2) Those parts of the unparished area of the former urban district of Chigwell which are marked C2 and C3 on boundary map 3 shall become part of the parish of Theydon Bois. The part marked C2 on boundary map 3 shall additionally be transferred to the Theydon Bois district ward and the Epping county electoral division.

Consequential electoral area changes

6. Those parts of the Theydon Bois district ward which are marked DW1 and DW2 on boundary map 3 shall be transferred to the Broadway district ward and to the Loughton St John's county electoral division.
