The Milton Keynes (Parishes) Order 1986

Made 21st February 1986

Coming into Operation -

for the purposes described	
in article 2(1).....	1st March 1986
for all other purposes..	1st April 1986

Whereas the Milton Keynes Borough Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the borough:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals and has implemented in the first instance the proposals contained in the Milton Keynes (Parish of Newport Pagnell) Order 1985 (b):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and Commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Milton Keynes (Parishes) Order 1986.

2. - (1) 1st March 1986 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976.

(2) For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1986.

Interpretation

3 - (1) In this order -

"borough ward" means a ward of the borough of Milton Keynes;

"the boundary map" means the map which is issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Map of the Milton Keynes (Parishes) Order 1986";

"county electoral division" means an electoral division of the county of Buckinghamshire; and

"the 1976 Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a).

Abolition of Parishes

4 - (1) The parish of Olney Park shall be abolished and its area transferred to the parish of Olney. The Olney Park parish trustees and parish meeting shall be dissolved. The Olney Parish Council shall be their residuary successor, and shall also assume custody of all the public books and documents of the abolished parish.

(2) The parish of Petsoe Manor shall be abolished, and its area transferred to the parish of Emberton. The Petsoe Manor parish trustees and parish meeting shall be dissolved. The Emberton Parish Council shall be their residuary successor, and shall also assume custody of all the public books and documents of the abolished parish.

Transfers between parishes

5.- (1) That part of the parish of Great Linford marked A2 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Haversham-cum-Little Linford, to the Stantonbury borough ward, and to the Olney county electoral division.

(2) That part of the parish of Stantonbury marked A1 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Haversham-cum-Little Linford, and to the Olney county electoral division.

(3) That part of the parish of Milton Keynes marked A4 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Moulsoe, and to the Petsoe Manor county electoral division.

(4) That part of the parish of Woolstone-cum-Willen marked A3 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Moulsoe and to the Petsoe Manor county electoral division.

Transfers from former urban district to parishes

6. - (1) That part of the area of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell marked C1 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Haversham-cum-Little Linford, to the Stantonbury borough ward, and to the Olney county electoral division.

(2) That part of the area of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell marked C2 on the boundary map shall be transferred to the parish of Moulsoe, to the Pineham borough ward and to the Petsoe Manor county electoral division.

(3) For the purpose of regulation 40 (statutory definitions of areas) of the 1976 Regulations, any reference to the area of the former urban district shall be construed as excluding the areas mentioned in paragraphs (1) and (2).

(4) Regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders & byelaws) of the 1976 Regulations shall apply to the area of the former urban district as if it were a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41(2). For the purposes of any provision in force to which that regulation applies, that area shall exclude the part mentioned in paragraphs (1) and (2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order)

This order affects parishes and the unparished area of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell in the borough of Milton Keynes.

It -

- (a) abolishes the parishes of Olney Park and Petsoe Manor, and transfers their areas to the parishes of Olney and Emberton respectively;
- (b) transfers parts of the parishes of Great Linford and Stantonbury to Haversham-cum-Little Linford;
- (c) transfers parts of the parishes of Woolstone-cum-Willen and Milton Keynes to the parish of Moulsoe;
- (d) transfers part of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell to the parish of Haversham-cum-Little Linford; and
- (e) transfers part of the former urban district of Newport Pagnell to the parish of Moulsoe.

The map forming part of this note (page 5) gives a general guide to the areas affected by this order as from 1st April 1986.

Prints of the detailed boundary maps referred to in articles 3, 5 and 6 may be inspected at the offices of the borough council, and may be inspected at or purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in articles 2(1), 3 and 6, contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.
