

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013

Made - - - - 28 March 2013

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council ("the council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 21 February 2013

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.



1. Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013.
- (2) Subject to paragraphs (3) and (4) below, this Order comes into force on 1st April 2015.
- (3) Articles 4 and 5 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015
- (4) For the purposes of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors for the parishes of Barwell, Shackerstone, Market Bosworth and Cadeby to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015, this Order shall come into force on 1 December 2014.

2. Interpretation

In this Order –

“borough” means the borough of Hinckley & Bosworth

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983¹

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Hinckley & Bosworth Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983²;

3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvements in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provisions of the Order

4. Number of parish councillors for the parish of Shackerstone:

(1) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Shackerstone shall remain at six.

(2) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish ward of Barton within the parish of Shackerstone shall reduce to one.

(3) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish ward of Congerstone within the parish of Shackerstone shall increase to two.

(4) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish ward of Bilstone within the parish of Shackerstone shall remain at one.

(5) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish ward of Odstone within the parish of Shackerstone shall remain at one.

(6) The number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish ward of Shackerstone within the parish of Shackerstone shall remain at one.

5. Change of parish ward names within the parish of Barwell:

- (1) The existing parish ward of Charnwood within the parish of Barwell shall be named St Mary's ward
- (2) The existing parish ward of St Mary's within the parish of Barwell shall be named Charnwood ward
- (3) The existing parish ward of Redhall within the parish of Barwell shall remain named Redhall ward

6. Alteration of areas of parishes affecting the parishes of Market Bosworth and Cadeby:

- (1) The area outlined in pink on the map shall cease to be a part of the parish of Cadeby and shall become part of the parish of Market Bosworth

7. Electoral register

The registration officer for the borough shall make such arrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order

8. Order date

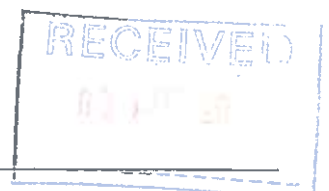
