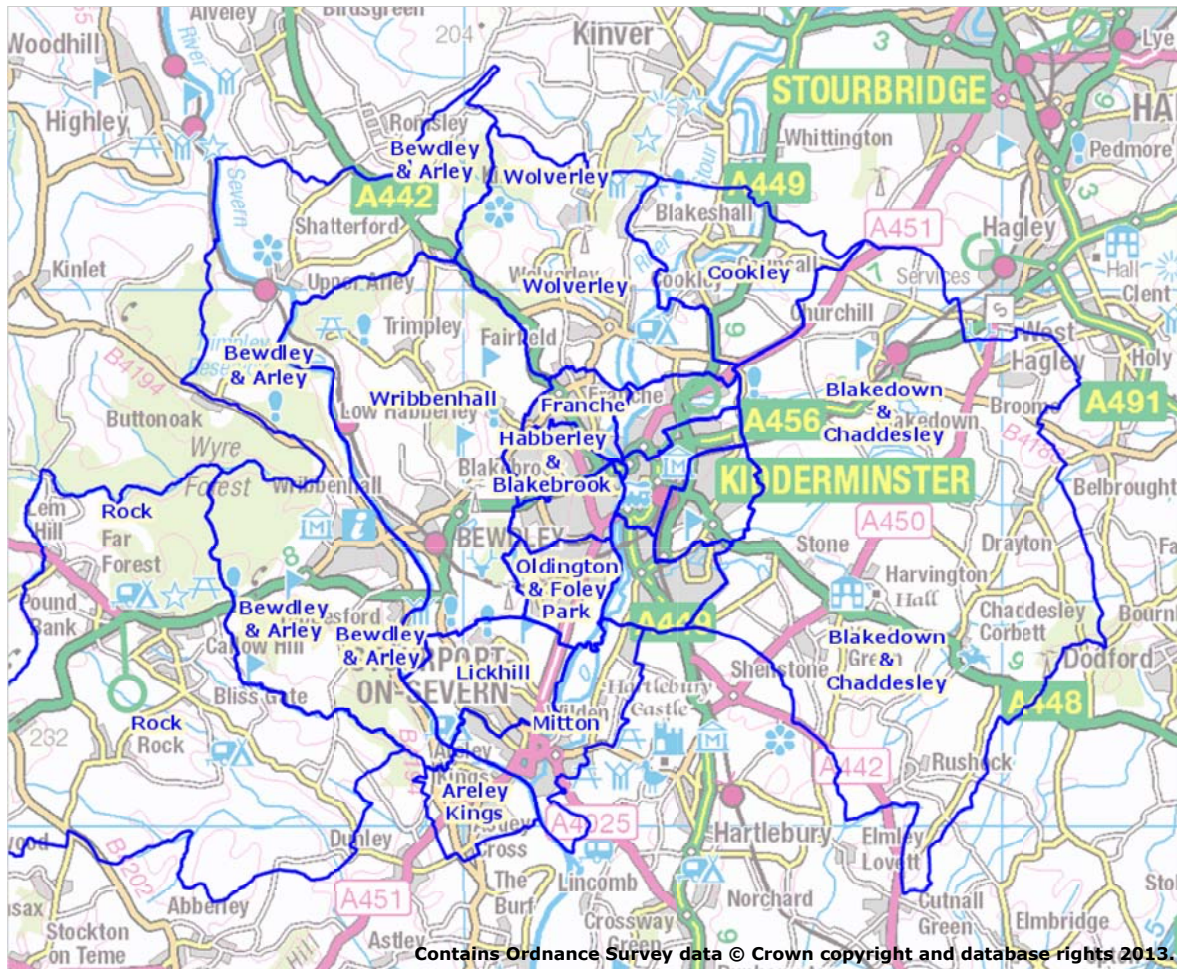

I would like to see Chaddesley Corbett separated from Blakedown along the lines of the parishes. The parishes of Stone and Chaddesley to have one District councillor, likewise, the parishes of Churchill & Blakedown with Broome to have their own District councillor. I am aware that this does not in any way alter the number of councillors for the district but, what it would mean is that Chaddesley Corbett and, indeed Blakedown would be represented by the councillor each village wants. At the moment, particularly in Chaddesley Corbett, the election of a district councillor is influenced to much by the Conservative majority in Blakedown. In most of the District elections since the two areas were merged, I believe the outcome of an elected councillor for Chaddesley Corbett would have been different had the vote not been influenced by voters in the Blakedown parishes. There is no common ground whatsoever between the two parishes and BOTH need to be able to choose their own representative without influence from the other.
