Comment text:

At Arlington's last parish council meeting we were informed that it is proposed that the Hellingly ward, which incorporates Arlington, is to be split as Hellingly has expanded through new housing. We were told that it is proposed that Arlington be split away from Hellingly and Arlington itself would be divided up between Hailsham and Alfriston. I strongly object to Arlington being split up. This makes little sense - there is a firm community bond between the people of Arlington, with plenty of well attended parish events. This includes Caneheath, Arlington Road West and Hempstead Lane. We were told that the reason for the changes is to even out ward populations. Although the numbers involved in Arlington Road West and Hempstead Lane are tiny we were told that the Hailsham Wards are already over target size. I suggest that a better solution would be to keep Arlington together and include it with Alfriston.
