As a residents association for South Woodford, we should like to comment on the Draft Redbridge Proposals.

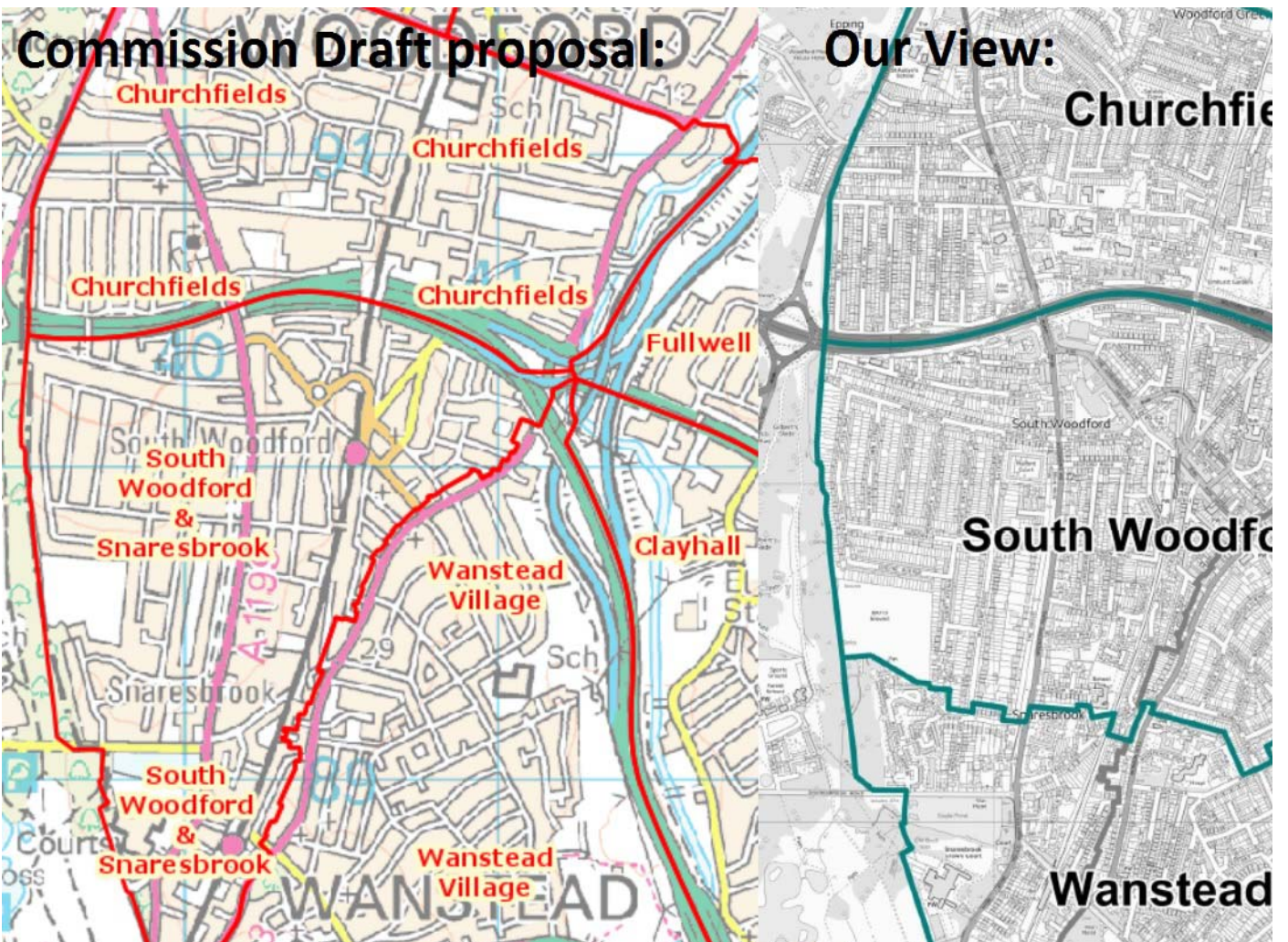
We can see the argument for using the A406 and M11 as new boundaries. However we think the way that the Commission has divided Wanstead from South Woodford doesn't make sense.

Hermon Hill and Chigwell Road aren't a natural boundary, as South Woodford people live on both sides and Chigwell Road, and roads like Onslow Gardens and South View Drive, are clearly part of South Woodford; residents here use South Woodford station and the shops in George Lane and the High Road. It is very odd to consider Wanstead Village going as far north as Charlie Brown roundabout!

Then the draft proposal divides Wanstead High Street, with part in the South Woodford & Snaresbrook ward, which also does not follow any useful natural divisions that locals can see.

Please have a look at this consider proposal as shown on the map below. This keeps the South Woodford area together, and also offers a more sensible Wanstead Village ward focused around Wanstead and Snaresbrook stations.

We would be interested to comment further and be prepared to meet with the Commission if they would consider it helpful.
