LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND**The Aylesbury Vale (Parishes) Order 2007**Made *5th February* 2007*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Aylesbury Vale (Parishes) Order 2007.

(2) It shall come into force—

(a) for the purposes of this article and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of election in 2007, on the day after that on which it is made; and

(b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2007.

(3) In this Order—

“existing” means existing on the date on which this Order is made;

“maps 1-13” means the maps prepared by the Department for Communities and Local Government, marked “Maps referred to in the Aylesbury Vale (Parishes) Order 2007” and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b); and

“the new parish” means the new parish constituted by article 2 of this Order.

Constitution of a new parish of Calvert Green

2.—(1) A new parish, comprising the area outlined in blue on map 1, shall be constituted within the district of Aylesbury Vale.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Calvert Green.

(3) In consequence of paragraph (1), the area of the new parish shall cease to be part of the existing parish of Charndon except for the area designated “A” which shall cease to be part of the existing parish of Steeple Claydon.

Parish Council for the new parish

3. The Aylesbury Vale District Council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the new parish constituted by article 2.

Alteration to Areas of Parishes

4. Each area shaded and designated by a letter on the maps and specified in column (1) of the Schedule of this Order shall cease to be part of the parish specified in the corresponding row of column (2) and shall become part of the parish specified in the corresponding row of column (3).

Transitional Provision

5. Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish at the elections to be held on the ordinary day of election in 2007 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by the person who is the elected councillor holding office immediately before 1st April 2007 for the ward of Marsh Gibbon in the district of Aylesbury Vale.

Order Date

6. 1st April 2007 is the Order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect (with modification) to recommendations resulting from a review conducted by the Aylesbury Vale District Council for the creation of one new parish and alterations to areas of parishes within the district of Aylesbury Vale. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the areas concerned.

Article 2 creates a new parish of Calvert Green.

Article 3 directs the Aylesbury Vale District Council to establish a parish council for the new parish.

Article 4 makes alterations to the areas of the parishes not involved in the creation of the new parish. On 1st April 2007 each area specified in column (1) of the Schedule to the Order will cease to be part of the parish area specified in column (2) and will become part of the parish area specified in column (3).

Article 5 provides for the parish of Calvert Green to be represented by the district councillor elected for the ward of Marsh Gibbon until councillors for the new parish, to be elected on the ordinary day of election in 2007, come into office.

Article 6 specifies 1st April 2007 as the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make provision of general application in relation to orders such as this Order.
