THE BOROUGH OF MELTON (PARISH COUNCILLORS)

(AMENDMENT) ORDER 1979

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

The Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) (Amendment) Order 1979, made by the Council of the Borough of Melton under Section 50(4) of the Local Government Act 1972.

REASONS :-

- (i) The Melton and Belvoir Rural District (Union of Parishes) Order 1936 made by the county council of Leicestershire on 28th January 1936 provided (inter alia) that the former parishes of Hoby and Ragdale be known as Hoby Ward of the parish of Hoby with Rotherby and that the former parishes of Brooksby and Rotherby be known as Rotherby Ward of the parish of Hoby with Rotherby,
- (ii) the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) Order 1975 made by the Council of the Borough of Melton (hereinafter called "the Council") on 1st August 1975 provided (inter alia) that three parish councillors should represent the Hoby Ward of the parish of Hoby with Rotherby, and two the Rotherby Ward of the said parish,
- (iii) the Parish Council of the parish of Hoby with Rotherby has made application for the wards of the parish and the number of parish councillors to be elected to be varied in manner hereinafter appearing.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 50(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) (Amendment) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the date of the election of parish councillors elected in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1972 in the year 1979 except for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election of parish councillors to be held on or after that date the Order shall be deemed to come into operation on such earlier date as may be necessary.
2. The existing wards of the parish of Hoby with Rotherby shall be abolished, and that part of the Melton and Belvoir Rural District (Union of Parishes) Order 1936 which provides for the said parish to be divided into two wards is hereby revoked.
3. The parish of Hoby with Rotherby shall be divided into four wards which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each such ward shall comprise the area designated on the map marked "MAP REFERRED TO IN THE BOROUGH OF MELTON (PARISH COUNCILLORS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1979" by reference to the name of the ward and demarcated by red lines thereon.
4. The part of the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) Order 1975 which provides that the number of parish councillors for the Hoby Ward shall be three and the number of parish councillors for the Rotherby Ward shall be two is hereby revoked.

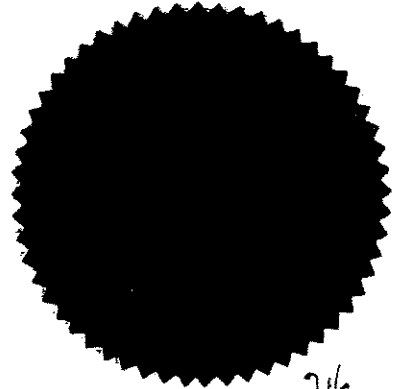
5. The number of councillors to be elected for each ward created by this Order shall be the number specified in column 2 of the said Schedule opposite to the name of the ward as given in column 1 of that Schedule.

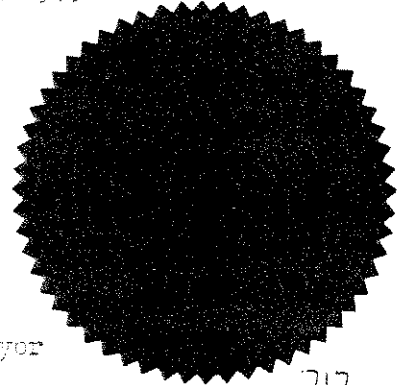
