

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010 relating to the Parishes of Whittlesford and Duxford

*Made this 18th day of August 2010
Coming into force with article 1(2)*

South Cambridgeshire District Council ("the Council"), in accordance with Section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (e) ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made a recommendation dated the 11th August 2010.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with Section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with Section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that Section (f):

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 86 and 240 (10) of the 2007 Act.

1. Citation and commencement(a)

- (1) This Order may be cited as the South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010 relating to the Parishes of Whittlesford and Duxford.
- (2) It shall come into force on 1st September 2010.

2. Interpretation

In this Order –

"county" means the county of Cambridgeshire;

"district" means the district of South Cambridgeshire

"existing" means existing on the date this Order is made;

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the South Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010" and deposited in accordance with Section 96 (4) of the 2007 Act; and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

3. Effect of Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under Section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

4. Alteration of parish areas of Whittlesford Parish and Duxford Parish

The area coloured yellow and designated by the letter "A" on the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Duxford shall become part of the parish of Whittlesford parish such proposal as further outlined in Schedule 1.

5. Order date

1st September 2010 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
