

## THE DISTRICT OF UTTLESFORD (REORGANISATION OF PARISH ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS) ORDER 2011

Made on 9 March 2011 and coming into force in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Order

This order is made pursuant to sections 86, 95 and 98 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 to change the electoral arrangements for the parishes listed in schedule 1 to this order, and to delay for one year ordinary elections scheduled to take place in the parishes listed in schedule 2, in the manner hereinafter contained.

1. This Order may be cited as The District of Uttlesford (Reorganisation of Parish Electoral Arrangements) Order 2011.
2. This Order comes into effect for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of parish councillors for those parishes listed in schedule 1, and shown on the map, that are due to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011, on the day after that on which it is made and, for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011.
3. This order comes into effect for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of parish councillors for those parishes listed in schedule 2, and shown on the map, on the day after that on which it is made.
4. Upon this order coming into effect the number of councillors assigned to the parishes and parish wards described in schedule 1 shall be the number specified in that schedule.
5. In this Order, the parishes and parish wards described in schedule 1 and in schedule 2 are those parishes and parish wards that exist on the date the Order is made.
6. In this order, "map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the District of Uttlesford (Reorganisation of Parish Electoral Arrangements) Order 2011.
7. Any previous Orders determining the number of parish councillors allocated to those parishes described in schedule 1 to this Order are revoked, insofar only as they relate to the parishes listed in that schedule, and not to any other parishes.

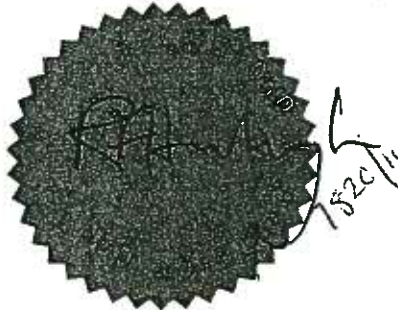

## Schedule 2

The ordinary election of parish councillors in the parishes of Birchanger, Little Canfield, Stansted Mountfitchet and Takeley is hereby postponed from the ordinary day of election in 2011 until the ordinary day of election in 2012 and the term of office of all existing parish councillors in each of those parishes is extended by one year until the fourth day after the ordinary day of election in 2012.

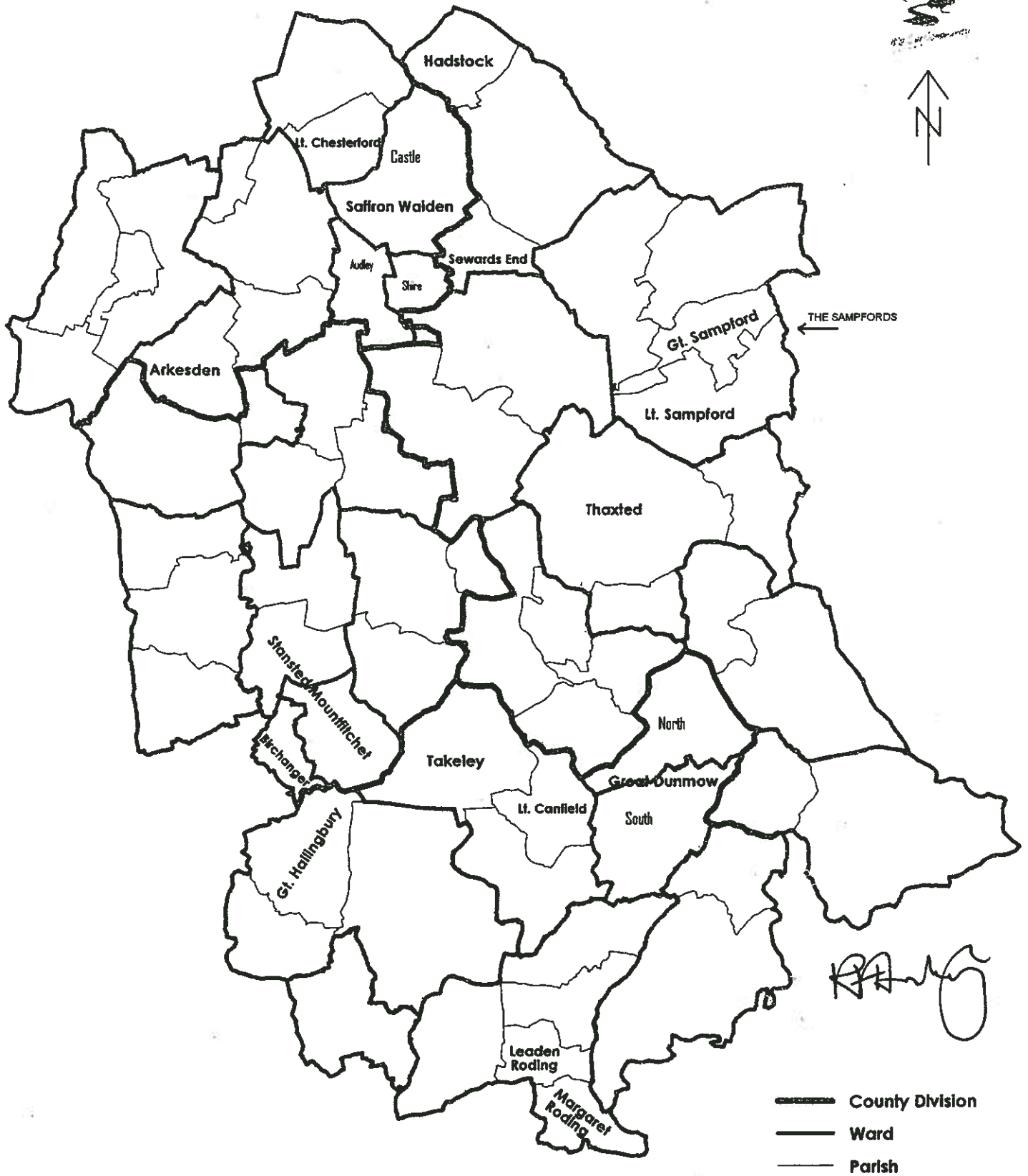

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Uttlesford District Council has reviewed the electoral arrangements for each of the parish councils in its area, except as noted in schedule 2 to the Order, and has decided to exercise its powers to change those arrangements in respect of the parishes listed in schedule 1.

The arrangements in respect of the parishes of Birchanger, Little Canfield, Stansted Mountfitchet and Takeley are still under review in respect of potential boundary changes and consequential changes to electoral arrangements as part of a community governance review. A separate order will be made in due course introducing revised electoral arrangements in those parishes. As a consequence of that review, the ordinary elections in those parishes are to be delayed by one year until the day of ordinary election in 2012 and the terms of office of the existing parish councillors in the parishes concerned are to be extended accordingly.
