

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT  
IN HEALTH ACT 2007**

**The Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of  
Community Governance) Order 2011**

*Made 26<sup>th</sup> January 2011*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council"), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act") has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations;

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient;

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section;

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

**Citation and commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011.
- (2) This Order comes into force on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order-
  - "Borough" means the Borough of Oldham;
  - "map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011 and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act;
  - "registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

### Alteration of parish area and parish ward

3. The area specified in column (1) of the Schedule to this Order and edged red and designated by the letter X on the map being part of an unparished area shall become part of the parish and parish ward specified in relation to that area in columns (2) and (3) of the schedule.

### Electoral register

4. The registration officer for the Borough shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of and in consequence of this Order.

### Order date

5. 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011 is the Order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Oldham Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Shaw and Crompton.

The parish of Shaw and Crompton will be altered with effect from 1 April 2011 by the addition to the parish of a small area of Lower Fullwood which contains 5 properties. This area lies within the Shaw electoral ward of Oldham Council but is not currently within the Shaw and Crompton parish. The alterations will mean that the whole of the Shaw electoral ward of Oldham Council also lies within the parish of Shaw and Crompton.

Article 4 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map defined in article 2 shows the new wards of the parish of Shaw and Crompton. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Oldham Council, Rochdale Road Reception, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham.
