

LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Wansdyke (Parishes) Order 1981

Made	- - - - -	17th September 1981
Coming into Operation — for the purposes described in article 2	- - - - -	16th February 1982
for all other purposes	- - - - -	1st April 1982

Whereas the District Council of Wansdyke, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the district;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 3rd October 1980, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Wansdyke (Parishes) Order 1981.
 2. 16th February 1982 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.
- For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—
 - “the appointed day” means 1st April 1982;
 - “the county” means the County of Avon;
 - “the district” means the District of Wansdyke;
 - “the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(c); and
 - “the Schedule” means the Schedule to this order.

The boundary maps

4. In this order —
- “the boundary maps” means the 10 maps printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey, each such map being marked “Map referred to in the Wansdyke (Parishes) Order 1981” and with the number of the map; and
- any reference to a numbered boundary map is a reference to the map described and numbered as aforesaid.

Changes in areas

- 5.—(1) The parts of parishes described in column (1) of the Schedule and marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (2) shall, in so far as parishes, wards thereof, electoral divisions of the county and wards of the district are specified in respect thereof in columns (3) to (6), be transferred to or form part of such areas.
- (2) The part of the Parish of Hitchurch which is shown cross-hatched red and marked B on boundary map 1 shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Keynsham North ward of the district.
- (3) The part of the area of the former urban district of Keynsham which is shown hatched red and marked C on boundary map 2 shall form part of the Parish of Compton Dando, of the Keynsham West electoral division of the county and of the Compton Dando ward of the district.

Statutory definitions of areas

6. In any application of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) (certain definitions of areas) of regulation 40 of the Regulations, the area to which article 5(2) applies shall be deemed to have been added to the area of the former urban district of Keynsham, and the area to which article 5(3) applies shall be deemed to have ceased to form part of such area

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

- 7.—(1) The area of the former urban district of Keynsham shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and is hereby specified in relation to paragraph (4) of that regulation, and the area comprising —
- the first mentioned area other than the part thereof to which article 5(3) applies; and
- the area to which article 5(2) applies
- is hereby specified in relation to the first mentioned area.
- (2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) of the Regulations in respect of any parish as altered.
