

Response to boundary commission's proposals for Warwickshire

Dear/sir madam

We write to object on the boundary commission proposals for the removal of Wembrook from the Nuneaton and Bedworth division

We fully support the county council and the borough proposals put forward as we feel that this allowed for the community tenure of the area to be preserved.

The community of Wembrook old hill top and new hill top have links with Caldwell and Coventry rd the area has similar issues, in terms of Deprivation skill levels and community cohesion

There is a Wembrook neighbourhood watch covering these areas these areas are also in the big local area granted £1 million over ten years and much work has been done to bring the community together on this By moving them to another county division the community will again lose their identity

In terms of the boundary criteria community tenure was an essential criteria along with co-terminosity both which seems to have been left out of your proposals

The co-terminosity across Nuneaton has changed from 13% to 7% as a result of changing from the county and borough proposals

I ask that you re consider the proposals and ask that you support the borough and county proposal put forward
