

THE BOROUGH OF MELTON (PARISH COUNCILLORS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 1998

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1997

The Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) (Amendment) Order 1998 made by the Council of the Borough of Melton under Section 17(3) of the Local Government Act 1997.

WHEREAS:-

- (i) the Melton and Belvoir Rural District (Union of Parishes) Order 1936 made by the County Council of Leicester on 29th January 1936 provided (inter alia) that:-
 - (a) the parish of Redmile be known as the Redmile Ward of the Parish of Redmile
 - (b) that the parishes of Plungar and Barkestone be known as the Barkestone Ward of the Parish of Redmile
- (ii) the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) Order 1975 made by the Council of the Borough of Melton (hereinafter called "the Council") on 1st August 1975 provided (inter alia) that:-
 - (a) three Parish Councillors should represent the Redmile Ward of the Parish of Redmile
 - (b) three Parish Councillors should represent the Barkestone Ward of the Parish of Redmile
- (iii) the Parish Council of the Parish of Redmile has made application for the wards of the Parish and the number of Parish Councillors to be elected to be varied in manner hereafter appearing

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 17 (3) of the Local Government Act 1997 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) (Amendment) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on the date of the election of Parish Councillors elected in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1997 in the year 1999 except for the purposes of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election of Parish Councillors to be held on or after that date the Order shall be deemed to come into operation on such earlier date as may be necessary.
2. The Parish of Redmile shall be divided into three wards which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each ward shall comprise the area designated on the map marked "**MAP REFERRED TO IN THE BOROUGH OF MELTON (PARISH COUNCILLORS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1998**" by reference to the name of the ward and demarcated by red lines thereon and shall be known as the Barkestone Plungar and Redmile Parish Council.

- 3. The part of the Borough of Melton (Parish Councillors) Order 1975 which provides that the number of Parish Councillors for the Redmile Ward shall be three and the number of Parish Councillors for the Barkestone Ward shall be three is hereby revoked

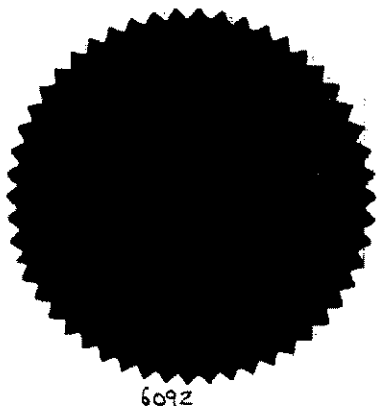

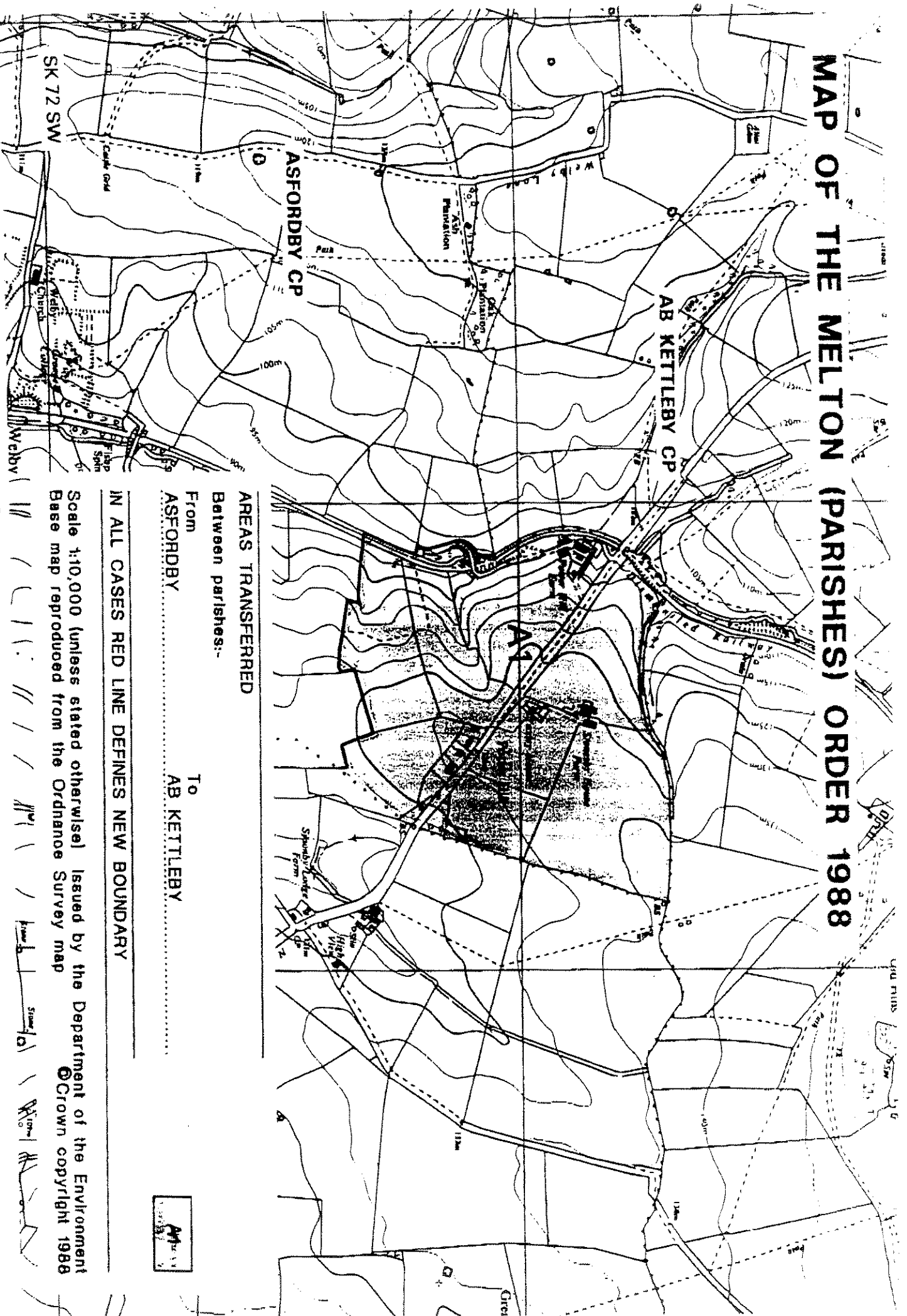

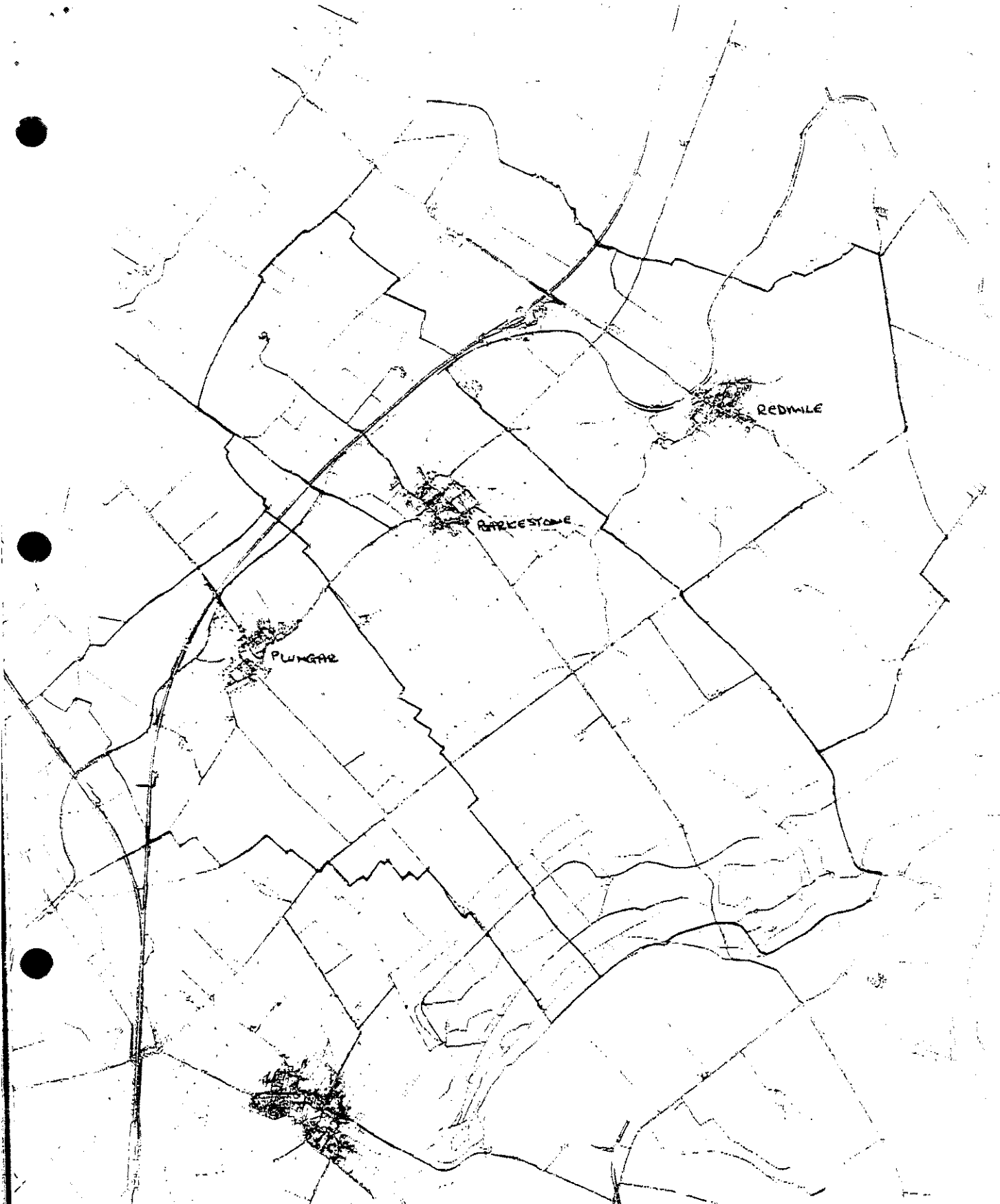
