The North West Leicestershire (Parishes) Order 1983

Whereas the District Council of North West Leicestershire, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the district:

And whereas the said Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, on 23rd November 1982, to make the recommended proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals without modification:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the North West Leicestershire (Parishes) Order 1983.

2.— (1) 1st January 1984 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

(2) For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1984.

Interpretation

3. In this order—
“the county” means the county of Leicestershire;
“the district” means the district of North West Leicestershire; and
“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a).

The boundary maps

4. In this order, “the boundary maps” means the 4 maps issued by the Department of the Environment in 2 sheets, each sheet being marked “Map sheet of The North West Leicestershire (Parishes) Order 1983”, and each map being marked with a letter, and any reference to a map by number and letter is a reference to the map so lettered on the sheet so numbered.

Changes in areas

5.—(1) The parts of parishes described in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order and marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (2) shall, in so far as parishes, wards thereof, electoral divisions of the county, wards of the district and petty sessional divisions are specified in respect thereof, in columns (3) to (7) be transferred to and form part of such areas.

(2) That part of the Parish of Osgathorpe marked B on boundary map 1b shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Coalville No. 2 county electoral division, of the Thringstone ward of the district, and of the Ashby de la Zouch petty sessional division.

(3) The parts of the area of the former urban district of Coalville marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, in so far as parishes, electoral divisions of the county, wards of the district and petty sessional divisions are specified in respect thereof in columns (2) to (5) be transferred to and form part of such areas.

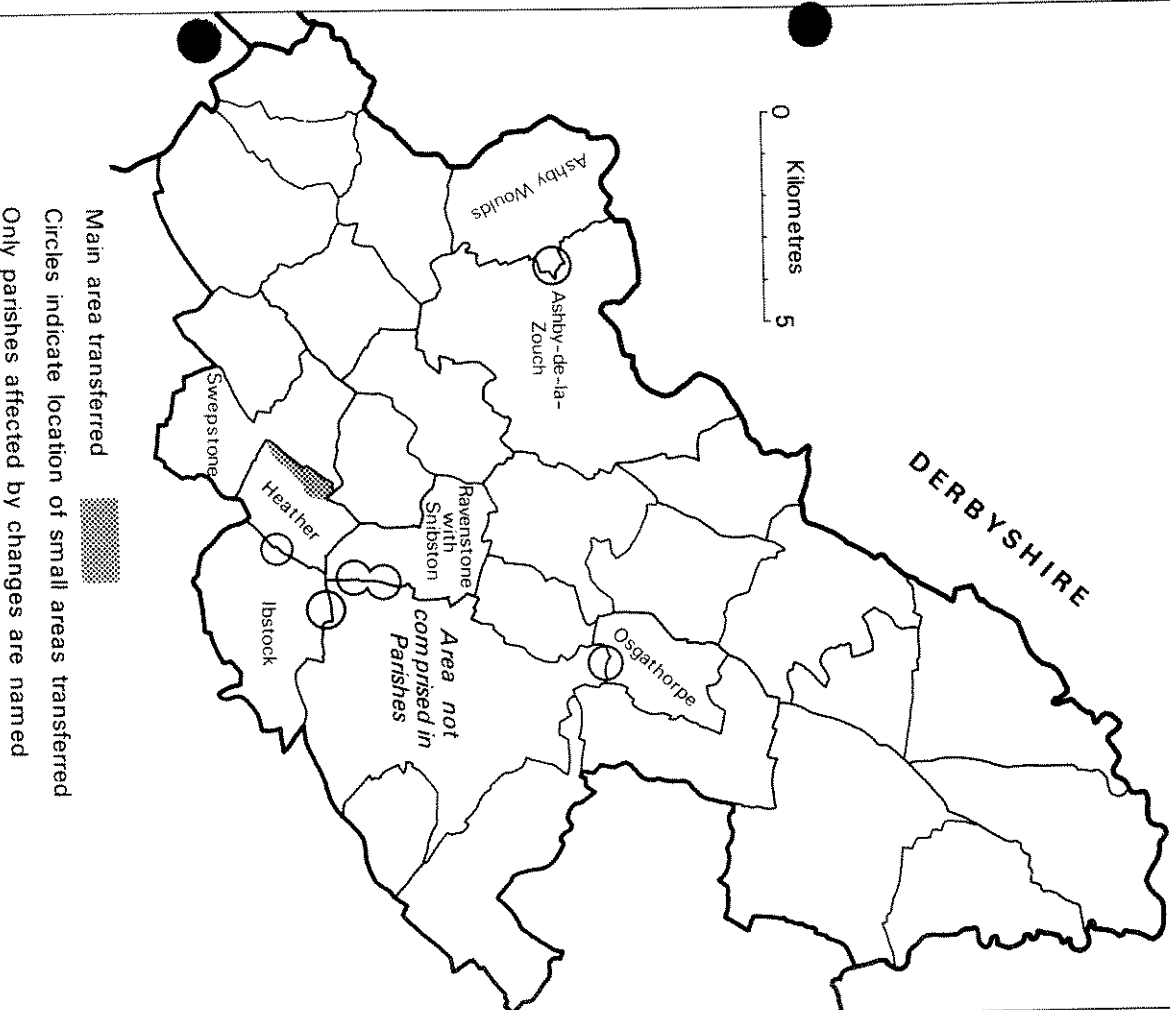
Statutory definitions of areas

6. In any application of paragraph (1) (statutory definitions of areas) of regulation 40 of the Regulations, the area to which article 5(2) applies shall be deemed to have been added to the area of the former urban district of Coalville, and the areas to which article 5(3) applies shall be deemed to have ceased to form part of such area.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

7.—(1) The area of the former urban district of Coalville shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order effects the transfer of—

- (a) parts of certain parishes in the district of North West Leicestershire to other parishes;
- (b) parts of the former urban district of Coalville to the parishes of Ibstock and Ravenstone with Snibston; and
- (c) part of the parish of Osgathorpe to the unparished area of the former urban district of Coalville.

The map forming part of this note (page 7) shows the areas affected as from 1st April 1984.

Prints of the maps referred to in article 4 may be inspected at the offices of the district council, and may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision for orders such as the present one is made by the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (see article 3).

(2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) of the Regulations in respect of any parish as altered.
