The Maldon (Parishes) Order 1999

Made - - - 19<sup>th</sup> January 1999

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect (without modification) to a recommendation made to him by Maldon District Council, following a review conducted by them in accordance with Part II of that Act, for the alteration of the area of parishes within the district of Maldon:

**Citation and commencement**

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the Maldon (Parishes) Order 1999.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 1st April 1999, except that for the purpose of any proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on 6th May 1999, it shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

**Alteration of parish areas**

2. - (1) The area marked "A" on the map is transferred from the parish of Tolleshunt D'Arcy to the parish of Tolleshunt Knights.

(2) In paragraph (1) "the map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions, marked "Map of the Maldon (Parishes) Order 1999" and deposited in the office of the Secretary of State and at the offices of the Maldon District Council.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order gives effect to a recommendation resulting from a review conducted by Maldon District Council. It transfers part of the parish of Tolleshunt D'Arcy to the parish of Tolleshunt Knights. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the area concerned.

The transfer does not involve any change in the district ward or county electoral division boundaries.
