CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS
The Tynedale (Parishes) Order 1986

Made 1st December 1986

Coming into Operation -

for the purposes described

in article 2(1) 1st January 1987

for all other purposes 1st April 1987

Whereas the Tynedale District Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parishes in the district:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Tynedale (Parishes) Order 1986.

2. - (1) 1st January 1987 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.

Interpretation

3. In this order -

"the boundary maps" means the 8 maps (duly numbered for reference) which are issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Maps of the Tynedale (Parishes) Order 1986";

"county electoral division" means an electoral division of the county of Northumberland; and

"district ward" means a ward of the district of Tynedale.

Transfer of areas common to two parishes

4. - (1) Those parts of the areas which are common to the parishes of Allendale and West Allen and which are marked A, B, E and F1 on boundary map 8 shall become part of the parish of Allendale.

(2) Those parts of the areas which are common to the parishes of Allendale and West Allen and which are marked C, D and F2 on boundary map 8 shall become part of the parish of West Allen.

Transfers between parishes

5. - (1) Each area marked on the boundary maps as shown in column 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the relevant parish named in column 3 to that named in column 4.

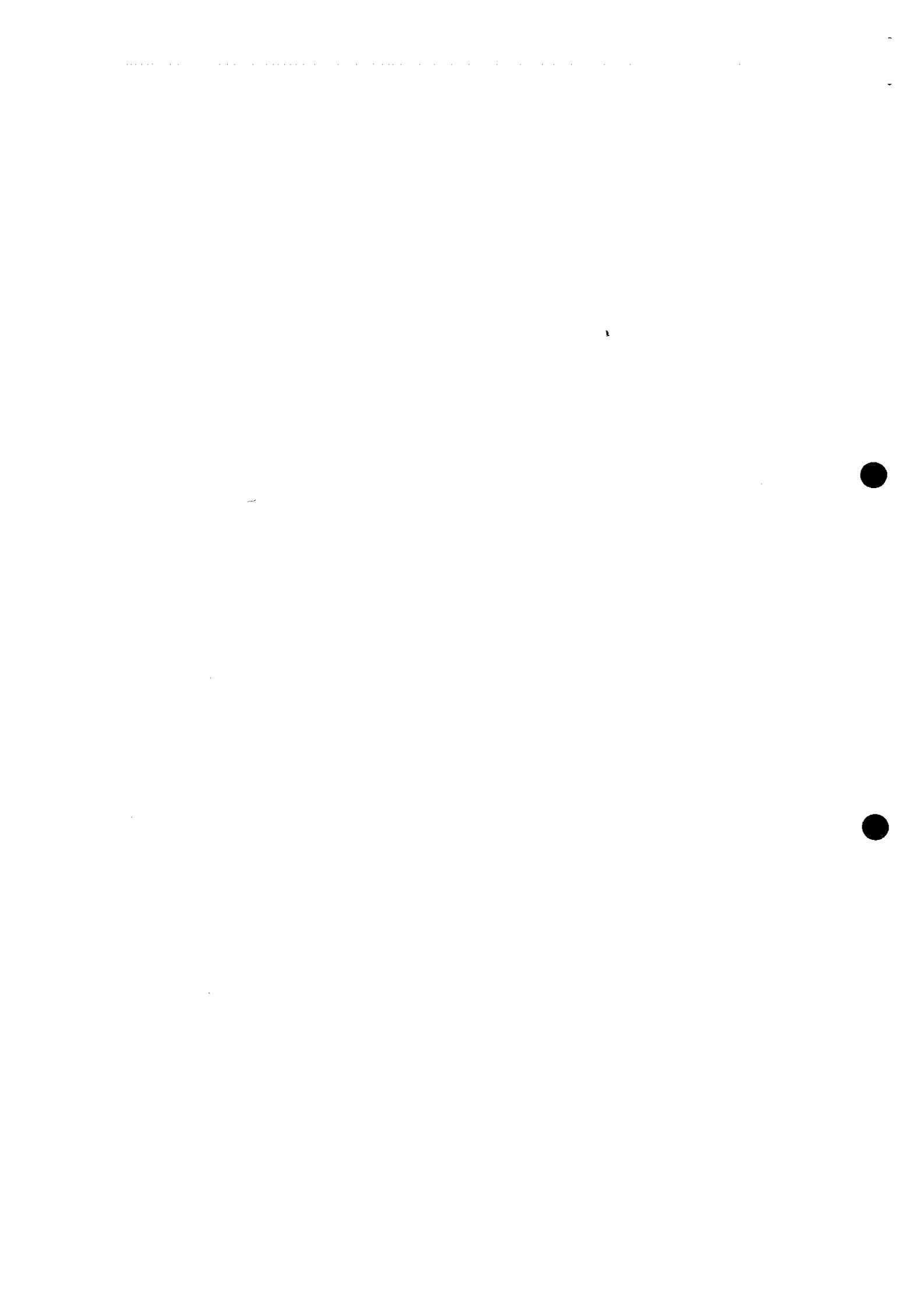

(2) Where in column 5 there is mentioned in relation to any area -

(a) a district ward; or

(b) a county electoral division

that area shall additionally be transferred to that ward or division.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order affects parishes in the district of Tynedale by

- (a) transferring areas common to the parishes of Allendale and West Allen to one or other of those parishes; and
- (b) transferring other areas between parishes.

The map forming part of this note (page 6) gives a general guide to the areas affected by this order as from 1st April 1987.

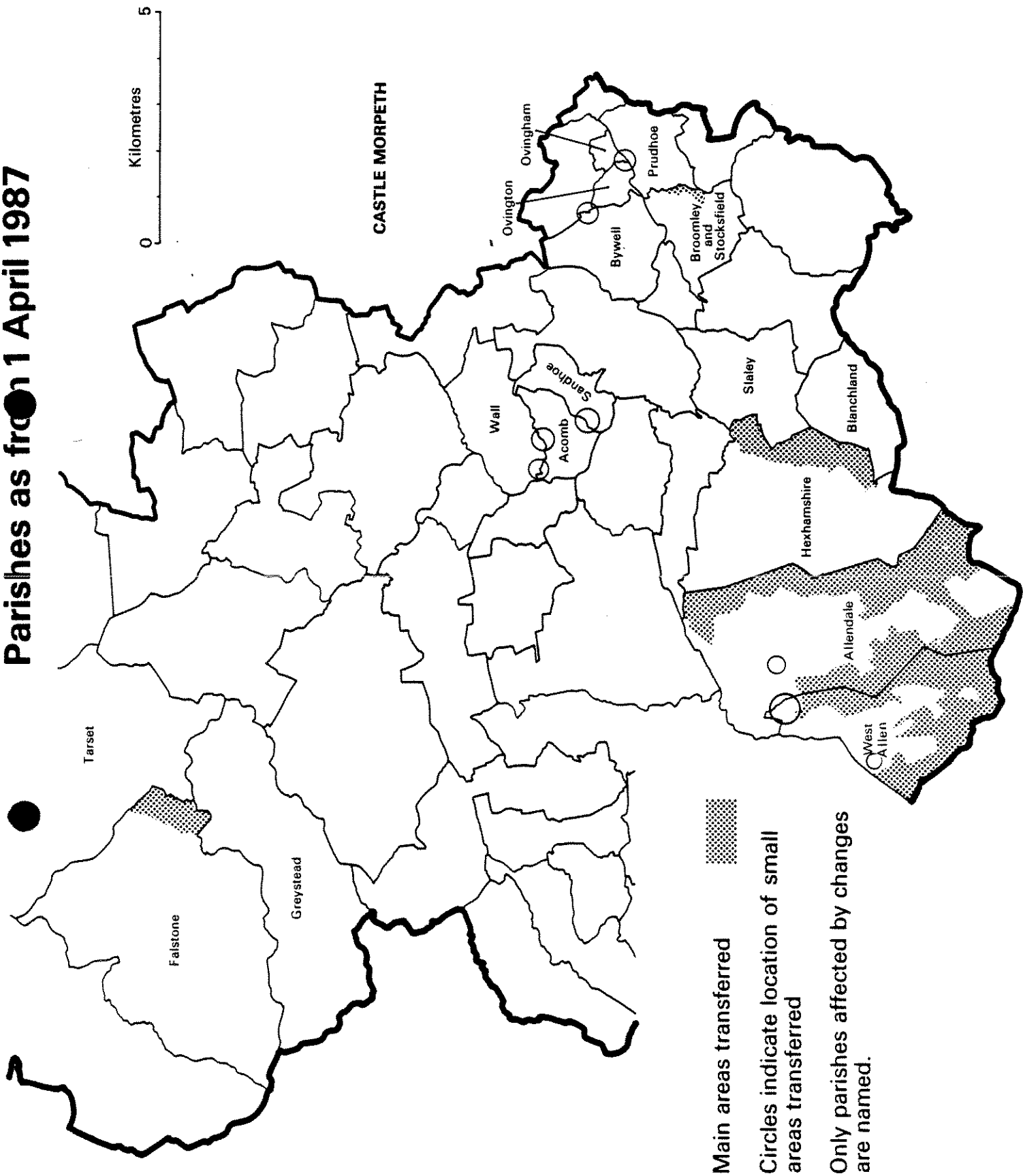
Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.
