Subject: LGBC & Luffield Abbey ward

Dear Sir/Madam,

Maids Moreton Conservation Group is concerned about possible changes to Luffield Abbey ward. At our meeting in the Village Hall on 16th September it was agreed that I should write to the LGBC to say that we do not think it a sensible or advantageous idea to include the new Moreton Road development within the boundaries of Luffield Abbey ward.

The reasons are that a District Councillor should reflect the views of his/her area. Currently Cllr Pearl Lewis represents eight rural parishes which have their own concerns of housing, transport, highways, planning etc. The new estate on the Moreton Road of 240 houses plus the extra 80 houses that have just been approved are within Buckingham parish, contain urban and social issues eg social housing and welfare, and we believe the estate should stay within Buckingham's councillors' remit.

In addition I understand that if Moreton Road estate was added to Luffield Abbey the need to attend both Buckingham Town Council plus the 8 parish councils would put an impossible demand on the voluntary district councillor in office.

We ask you to allow Luffield Abbey to continue as a homogenous unit in the interests of common sense and effective local government representation.
