The Conservative Group at Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council joins with our counterparts at Shire Hall and welcome the report on the future boundary arrangements for Warwickshire County Council. We firmly believe that having 57 single member divisions gives the fairest representation to residents across the County, as opposed to some districts retaining some dual member divisions.
