The Birmingham (Parishes) Order 1999

Made - - - - 10th December 1999

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect (without modification) to a petition sent to him under section 11 of that Act, for the constitution as a parish of an area within the city of Birmingham, of which no part is within a parish, and for the establishment of a parish council for that area:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the Birmingham (Parishes) Order 1999.

(2) It shall come into force on the day after that on which it is made.

(3) In this Order "the map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions, marked "Map of the Birmingham (Parishes) Order 1999", and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999 (b).

Constitution of new parish

2. - (1) A new parish, comprising the area delineated by a blue line on the map, shall be constituted within the city of Birmingham.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be New Frankley in Birmingham.



Direction to establish parish council

3. - (1) The Birmingham City Council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the parish of New Frankley in Birmingham.

(2) 1st April 2000 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to a petition sent to the Secretary of State, for the creation as a parish of an area within the city of Birmingham, and for the establishment of a parish council for that area.

Article 2 creates the new parish, to be called New Frankley in Birmingham. The new parish will comprise parts of the Longbridge district electoral ward.

Article 3 directs the Birmingham City Council to establish a parish council for the new parish and specifies 1st April 2000 as the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.
